Eliminate Taxpayer-Subsidized Union Activities

March 9, 2010

<u>Program or Item Targeted</u>: Taxpayer-subsidized union activities among federal employees.

<u>One-Year Cost of Program or Item</u>: According to a recent OPM survey, over \$120 million for fiscal year 2008 was spent by 61 federal agencies on union activities.

Background on Program or Item to Be Sunseted: Federal law (Title V, United States Code) allows federal employees to use official time for union activities, including collective bargaining and arbitration of grievances.

Why This Program or Item Is Wasteful: Recent increases in union activity have led to a less efficient federal workforce. The Office of Personnel Management (OPM) conducted an extensive survey of 61 executive agencies and departments for fiscal year 2008 outlining the number of official time hours and amount of time wage cost spent on union activity. OPM reported that 2,893,922 official time hours were used in collective bargaining or arbitration of grievances against an employer in fiscal year 2008. Further, the report found that in FY 2008 alone, the federal government spent \$120,730,471 on these same union activities, an increase from \$113,038,094 in FY 2007. While families all over the nation are tightening their belts and cutting down their own spending, taxpayers should not be forced to subsidize union activities for federal employees.

Legislative Steps Taken So Far: Rep. Phil Gingrey (R-GA) has introduced H.R. 122, the Federal Employee Accountability Act of 2011. This legislation repeals two sections of the Civil Service Reform Act of 1978 and will ensure that no employee of the federal government can use official time to collectively bargain on behalf of a union against their employer.
