A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Homeland Security to conduct a study and report to Congress on gaps in port security in the United States and a plan to address them.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Gauging American
- 5 Port Security Act" or the "GAPS Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. STUDY, REPORT, AND PLAN TO ADDRESS GAPS IN
- 7 PORT SECURITY.
- 8 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment
- 9 of this Act the Secretary of Homeland Security shall—

1	(1) conduct a study of, and submit to the Con-
2	gress a classified report on, remaining gaps in port
3	security in the United States; and
4	(2) include in such report a prioritization of
5	such gaps and a plan for addressing them.
