Application Procedure

Note to Applicant: You are being considered for a nomination to one or more of the service academies. You will not be considered for an academy which you have not designated as your choice on the application form. However, you must meet the scores listed on the "Minimum Requirements" for the respective academy in order to be scheduled for an interview.

- 1. Application Form Complete application form and attach a photograph.
- 2. **Recommendation Forms** Ask your high school counselor or principal to complete one recommendation form, and choose two others to fill out a form, such as a math or science teacher, coach, employer, or someone who knows you well. Have them return the completed form to you in a sealed envelope with their signature across the seal.
- 3. <u>Transcripts</u> Ask your counselor or principal for a copy of your transcripts and make sure the transcript includes your course listing and grades, current G.P.A., and class rank. The transcript should be returned to you in a sealed envelope with a signature across the seal.
- 4. <u>Standardized Test Results</u> To have scores forwarded to our office directly from the testing center, please use the following codes: S.A.T. 0275 A.C.T. 7341. Many transcripts will include copies of your SAT or ACT scores. If so, this is sufficient and you need not send in separate score results, unless you have updated scores. No scores will be accepted after the first business day in November.
- 5. <u>Deadline</u> Send the above information to the Miami office. Completed application packets must be received by the first business day in November.
- 6. <u>Interview</u> Interviews are held in mid-November, at the District Office in Miami. <u>Qualified</u> candidates will be scheduled for a fifteen-minute interview. If you are unable to attend, you must send a written request for a waiver with your application packet. Waivers will be granted only to those who have a military obligation or whose parents are stationed overseas on assignment.

Application Schedule

March - November - COMPLETE PACKET

Candidates must complete application packets and return them to Congressman Mario Díaz-Balart's District Office.

First Business Day of November - DEADLINE!

All required information for a completed application packet <u>must be received by this date</u>. Please use sufficient postage.

Mid-November - INTERVIEW

<u>Qualified</u> candidates are interviewed for approximately 15 minutes by Congressman Mario Díaz-Balart's Service Academy Advisory Board. Interviews are held at the District Office, in Miami.

Early January - NOTIFICATION

Congressman Mario Diaz-Balart submits nominations to the academies and notifies all interviewed candidates of nominaiton status a few weeks after the scheduled interview.

<u>December - May</u>

Although some appointments are offered beyond May, the academies will make the majority of appointments between December and May.

Late June or Early July

Appointed cadets are due at the U.S. service academies.
