#### Security Seminar in Orlando, Florida

The Center for Development of Security Excellence (CDSE) attended the 48th Annual NCMS seminar at Disney's Yacht & Beach Resort from June 11 to June 15. The theme of this year's conference was "Sailing to New Security Heights." Over 1,200 security professionals attended, representing industry and a limited number of Government agencies. CDSE was one of only three government vendors present and distributed CDSE-themed brochures and other DSS-related handouts, such as DSS Counterintelligence Directorate handouts and 2011 Targeting U.S. Technologies: A Trend Analysis of Reporting from Defense Industry.

Defense Security Service Director Stanley L. Sims provided the keynote speech on Wednesday. He also honored 26 facilities in the National Industrial Security Program with the James S. Cogswell Outstanding Industrial Security Achievement Award. He noted, "This number equates to one-tenth of one percent of 13,300 NISP cleared facilities — an elite group! The Cogswell Award is the most prestigious honor DSS



bestows on cleared facilities. The number of awards we present each year has typically averaged between 10 and 20, but this year there were 26. To help put the number in further perspective, we recognized just nine companies in 2010. Last year, I was pleased to see an increase to 17 and even more thrilled this year to see the number rise to 26. The extremely small percentage of facilities awarded each year shows how hard it is to achieve two consecutive superior assessments and how significant the award is to our industry partners. But the steady increase in the number of facilities we are recognizing also shows the importance industry places on the award as all 13,300 facilities strive to achieve it."

#### Professional Development Units (PDU) Catalog Now Available on the Website

You've worked hard to earn that certification, don't lose it now. Security professionals conferred the SFPC or the Security Asset Protection Professional Certification (SAPPC) must accrue 100 PDUs within a 2-year cycle. At least 50 percent of the 100 PDUs must be fulfilled through approved professional development activities focusing on security topic areas. The remaining PDUs must be fulfilled through approved professional development activities focusing on core academic topic areas. Please note that the certification renewal clock for SFPC and SAPPC is on hold pending implementation by the SPēD PMO of technology systems for managing PDUs. This delay will be effective until October, 2012 at which time the renewal policy will be reviewed.

#### **DSS Assists the Department of the Navy**

At the Department of the Navy's request, DSS SPēD Program Management Office (PMO) offered SFPC & SAPPC assessments during the Department of the Navy's Security Manager's Conference. The conference was held at the National Conference Center in Leesburg, VA, May 15-17, 2012. SFPC and SAPPC assessments were held four times daily. Approximately 80 security professionals participated from the DoD community. The Deputy Under Secretary of the Navy for Plans, Policy, and Oversight, Mr. Robert Martinage, presided over the Department of the Navy's SFPC Conferral Ceremony.





# **National Commission for Certifying Agencies Accreditation (NCCA) Update**

The NCCA application for SFPC accreditation has passed the initial stage and will soon be fully reviewed. CDSE plans to submit the Adjudicator Certification Program for review next. The NCCA has accredited over 200 programs for more than 100 organizations. Accreditation is awarded based on the certification's processes and products rather than subject matter, and thus NCCA certification is applicable to a variety of professions.
