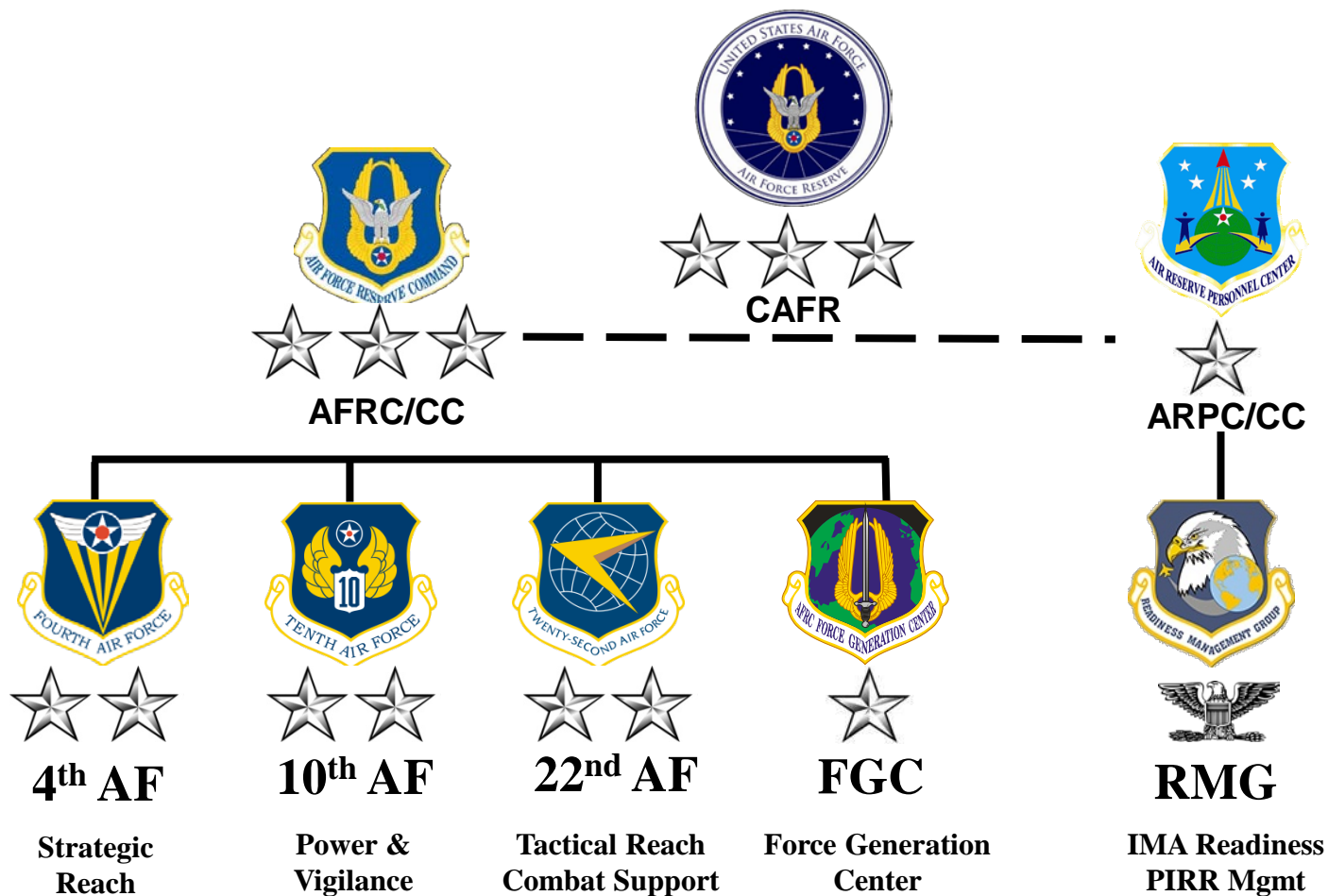

# Organizational Structure



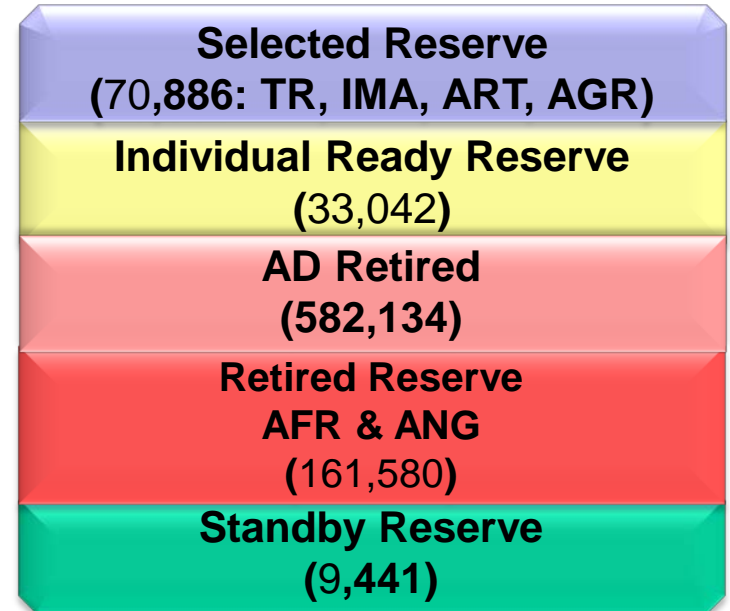
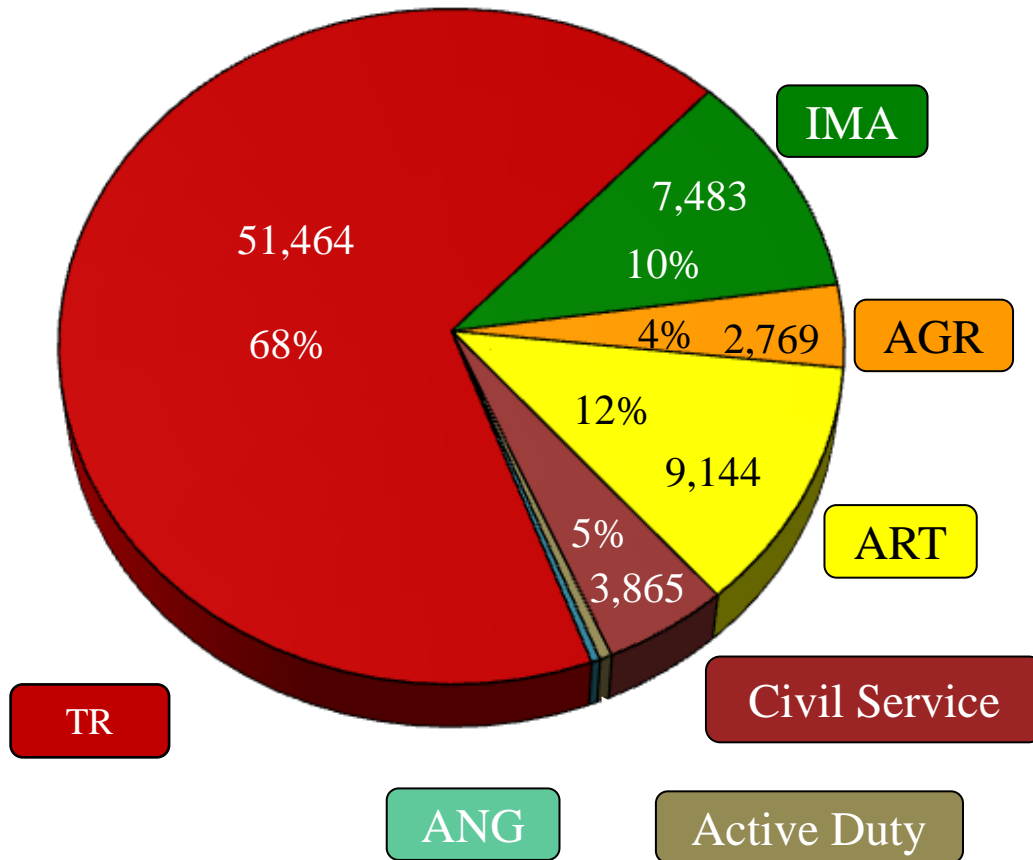
