UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENTS

S. 3457 (ORDER NO. 476)

1.—*Ordered*, That at 2:15 p.m. on Tuesday, September 11, 2012, the Senate vote on the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed to S. 3457, a bill to require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to establish a veterans jobs corps, and for other purposes; provided, that with respect to the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed, the mandatory quorum required under Rule XXII be waived. (*Aug. 2, 2012.*)

S. 3414 (ORDER NO. 470)

2.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the motion to invoke cloture on S. 3414, a bill to enhance the security and resiliency of the cyber and communications infrastructure of the United States, the mandatory quorum required under Rule XXII be waived.

Ordered further, That the filing deadline for second degree amendments to S. 3414 be at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 2, 2012. (*July 31, Aug. 1, 2012.*)

S. 3220 (ORDER NO. 410)

3.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed to S. 3220, a bill to amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to provide more effective remedies to victims of discrimination in the payment of wages on the basis of sex, and for other purposes, the mandatory quorum required under Rule XXII be waived. (*May 24, 2012.*)
