COMMANDER'S ENVIRONMENTAL POSITION STATEMENT


Otis Air National Guard Base (Otis ANGB) is now the home of the 102d Intelligence Wing. We are currently in the process of acquiring our new mission and educating ourselves for our new responsibility of overseeing a Distributed Ground Station (DGS) in addition to an Air Operations Center (AOC) which began 1 October 2008.

Although our mission mandates have changed in the past several years, environmental protection remains a primary management responsibility, as well as the responsibility of every worker and supplier and an important measure of performance as a whole. Our vision is to reduce waste through pollution prevention, continually improve our environmental performance, and maintain compliance with all environmental regulations albeit federal, state, municipal, county or local.
