Dear Secretary LaHood:

Pursuant to Title XV, Subtitle A, Section 1511 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Pub. L. 11-5 (Feb. 17, 2009)) (ARRA), I, Ted Strickland, Governor of the State of Ohio, hereby certify (Certification #13) that the attached infrastructure investments funded with amounts appropriated by ARRA under the following headings have received the full review and vetting required by law and that I accept responsibility that such investments are appropriate uses of taxpayer dollars:

- "Highway Infrastructure Investment" (to the Federal Highway Administration)
- "Transit Capital Assistance"
- "Fixed Guideway Infrastructure Investment"
- "Capital Investment Grants" (to the Federal Transit Administration)

I further certify that the specific information required by Section 1511 concerning each investment (a description of the investment, the estimated total cost, and the amount of ARRA funds to be used) is provided on Ohio's Recovery Act website, www.recovery.ohio.gov, and on the Ohio Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) and is available to the public at

As we continue to amend the STIP to include projects funded using ARRA monies, we will submit additional Section 1511 certifications. This particular certification includes projects within the Akron Area Metropolitan Transportation Study (AMATS, Akron, Ohio), Clark County-Springfield Transportation Coordinating Committee (CCSTCC, Springfield, Ohio), Eastgate Regional Council of Governments (Eastgate, Youngstown, Ohio), Licking County Area Transportation Study (LCATS, Newark, Ohio), Lima-Allen County Regional Planning Commission (LACRPC, Lima, Ohio), Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission (MVRPC, Dayton, Ohio), Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA, Cleveland, Ohio), Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments (OKI, Cincinnati, Ohio), Stark County Area Transportation Study (SCATS, Canton, Ohio), and Toledo Metropolitan Area Council of Governments (TMACOG, Toledo, Ohio) areas. I understand that my state or local agency may not receive ARRA infrastructure investment funding unless this certification is made and posted.
