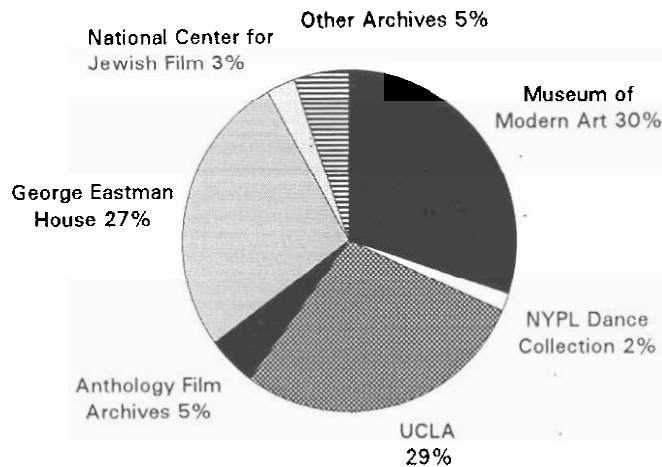


Figure 6: AFI-NEA Film Preservation Grant Distribution, 1979-92
