UNTHSC Immunization and Screening/Testing Policy

For students who will not have direct patient contact

This includes all public health students and select GSBS students.

Required titers: Titers are blood tests that show whether you have immunity to a specific disease. Titers for Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Hepatitis B, and Varicella (chicken pox) are required only if no official immunization records are obtainable. If you have a history of chicken pox you do not need a Varicella titer drawn.

Required immunizations: Official documentation of the immunizations listed below is required. Please send these records to the Student Health Clinic.

Hepatitis B -3 doses

Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) -2 doses (or Measles 2 doses, Rubella 1 dose, and Mumps 1 dose) Inactivated Polio (IPV) - 4 doses

Diptheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DTP) -5 doses

Varicella -2 doses (or history of chicken pox during childhood)

Tetanus, Diptheria (Td) booster or Tetanus, Diptheria, Acellular Pertussis (Tdap) within last 10 years

Required tuberculosis testing: Annual PPD skin test for tuberculosis is required for <u>all</u> UNTHSC students. If you have previously received BCG vaccine you will still require an annual PPD skin test. If you have a <u>history of a positive PPD</u> schedule an appointment with a student health physician and bring all records with you.

History and Physical: Not required
