Dear Madam Secretary,

According to the Department of the Treasury the Department of Homeland Security received \$345.72 million in Treasury Forfeiture Funds in fiscal year 2010. The Department of the Treasury states that the Bureau of Customs and Border Protection received \$65.343 million, the Bureau of Immigration and Customs Enforcement received \$154.14 million, the Secret Service received \$121.724 million, the United States Coast Guard received \$4.18 million, and the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center received \$0.345 million in fiscal year 2010. Given the magnitude of the aforementioned funds we request the Department clarify how the money was used by DHS and its components.
