Dear Secretary Bose:

The purpose of this communication is to inform the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) that the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (PREPA) has recently revised its Capacity Expansion Plan in consideration of key environmental and fuel diversification goals of the Government of Puerto Rico's Public Energy Policy Plan.

This Capacity Expansion Plan includes a new Natural Gas Combined Cycle (NGCC) power facility that will be constructed in the vicinity of the existing PREPA owned South Coast Steam Power Plant and the EcoEléctrica LNG Import Terminal, located on the south coast of the island, in the municipality of Guayanilla. The first phase of this new project will include a 270 MW generating facility that will be powered by natural gas, supplied from the EcoEléctrica LNG Import Terminal, which remains the only source of natural gas in Puerto Rico.

PREPA is aware that on April 16, 2009 the FERC issued EcoEléctrica an Order Amending Authorization Under Section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (Order), approving certain modifications to the EcoEléctrica LNG Import Terminal to supply natural gas to PREPA for use in its Aguirre Combined Cycle Power Plant. In consideration of the abovementioned revised Capacity Expansion Plan, PREPA will fully support EcoEléctrica if any modification is required to the April 16, 2009 Order, to reflect the foregoing change in destination of the natural gas from the Aguirre Combined Cycle Power Plant to the new South Coast NGCC.
