Crop sales accounted for \$172,556 of the total value in 2002.

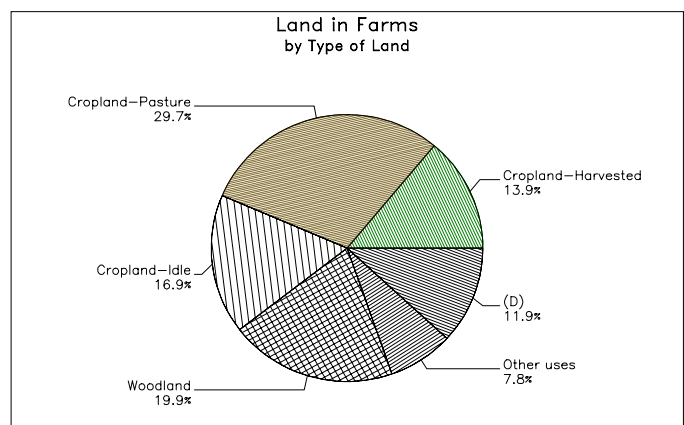
