Crop sales accounted for \$1,111,798 of the total value in 2002.

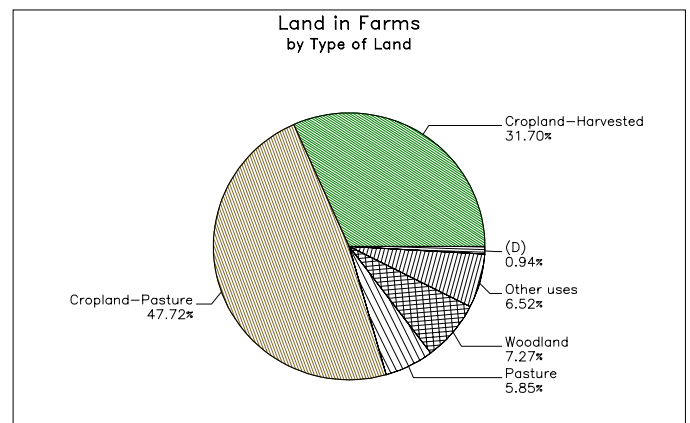
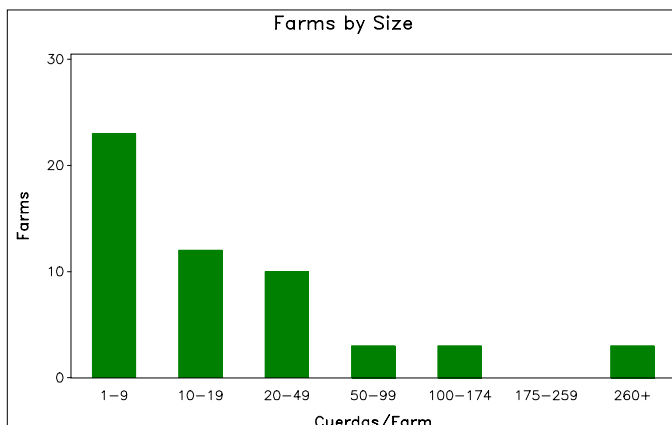
