Crop sales accounted for \$3,504,386 of the total value in 2002.

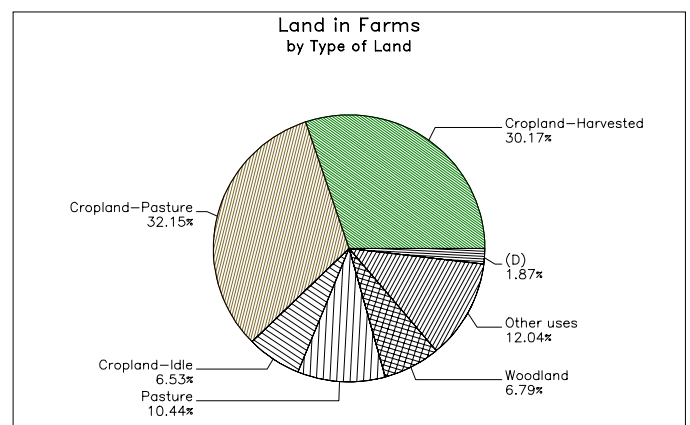
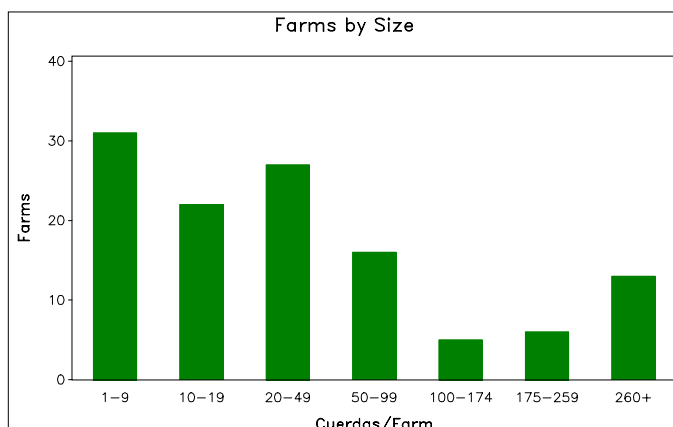
Livestock sales accounted for \$1,588,744 of the total value in 2002.
