Crop sales accounted for \$2,446,253 of the total value in 2002.

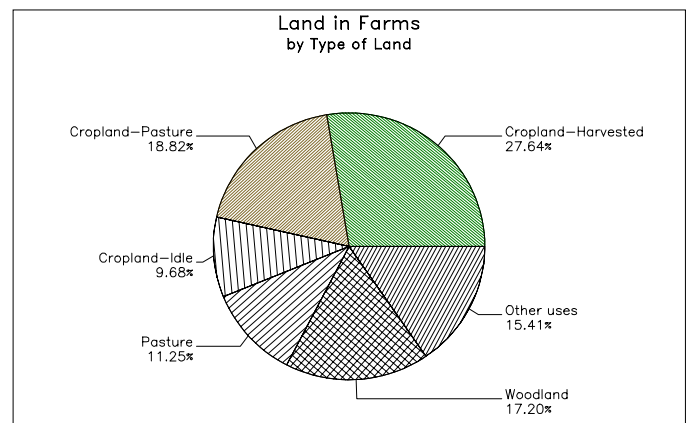
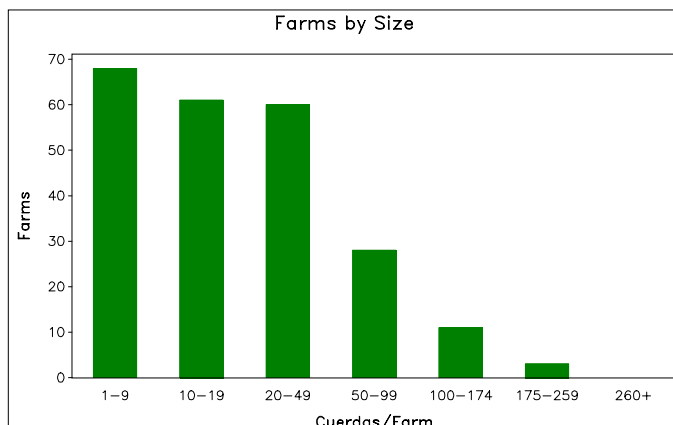
