UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENT
(Paul A. Crotty [Cal. No. 38])

Ordered, That at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 11, 2005 the Senate proceed to executive session for the consideration of the nomination of Paul A Crotty, of New York, to be United States District Judge for the Southern District of New York; provided further, that there be 30 minutes for debate equally divided between the Chairman of the Committee on the Judiciary (Mr. Hatch) and Ranking member (Mr. Leahy) or their designees and that at the expiration or yielding back of time the Senate proceed to a vote on the confirmation of the nomination with no intervening action or debate; provided further, that following the vote the President be immediately notified of the Senate's action and the Senate then resume legislative session.
