GPO TEAMS WITH BARNES & NOBLE TO SELL FEDERAL eBOOKS

WASHINGTON—The U.S. Government Printing Office (GPO) has signed an agreement with Barnes & Noble to sell Federal eBooks. Titles are available in eBook format for Barnes & Noble's Nook eReader. GPO works with Federal agencies to produce their publications, books, and reports in print and digital formats, including eBook formats. Approximately 30 eBook titles are available including popular titles like the *Public Papers of the President-Barack Obama*, *Deep Water: The Gulf Oil Disaster And The Future Of Offshore Drilling* (the BP Oil Spill Commission Report), the *Financial Crisis Inquiry Report*, and the newly released *Basic Guide to Exporting* from the Department of Commerce. GPO makes eBooks available in partnership with Google's eBookstore, OverDrive, Ingram, Zinio, and other online vendors.
