GPO'S PUEBLO DISTRIBUTION CENTER SCORES HIGH ON CUSTOMER SATISFACTION SURVEY

WASHINGTON—The U.S. Government Printing Office's (GPO) Congressman Frank Evans Document Distribution Center in Pueblo, Colorado achieved a high score for its customer service. The American Customer Satisfaction Index (ACSI) measures the customer satisfaction of more than 225 companies and 100 Government agencies in more than 47 industries. GPO's Pueblo facility received an overall customer satisfaction score of 84 points with low complaints at only one percent. The ACSI surveyed customers on their satisfaction with catalog, Web site, phone, and order processing. This high customer satisfaction score builds upon the Pueblo distribution center's reputation for excellent customer service and high scores from previously conducted surveys.

Employees at the Congressman Frank Evans Pueblo Document Distribution Center work with the General Services Administration's Federal Citizen Information Center to process customer orders. The center is responsible for processing and distributing orders for consumer publications. The facility opened for business in 1971, and since that time, it has distributed approximately one billion publications worldwide.
