**A BILL**

To require the Secretary of the Army to operate the Buford  
Dam/Lake Sidney Lanier Project, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INDUSTRIAL AND MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLY,**

4                   **LAKE SIDNEY LANIER, GEORGIA.**

5       (a) REQUIREMENT OF SECRETARY OF THE ARMY.—

6 Subject to subsection (b), the Secretary of the Army (act-  
7 ing through the Chief of Engineers) (referred to in this  
8 section as the “Secretary”) shall operate the Buford Dam/  
9 Lake Sidney Lanier Project—

1           (1) for the purpose of municipal and industrial  
2           water supply; and

3           (2) notwithstanding each limitation described in  
4           section 301(d) of the Water Supply Act of 1958 (43  
5           U.S.C. 390b(d)), to include storage in the project  
6           for water supply.

7           (b) **CONDITION.**—Subsection (a) shall not apply un-  
8           less the non-Federal sponsor of the water supply storage  
9           described in subsection (a) pays the cost for the capital  
10          investment for reallocated storage space in accordance  
11          with each procedure that the Secretary determines to be  
12          necessary.
