AN ACT

To direct the Administrator of General Services to install a photovoltaic system for the headquarters building of the Department of Energy.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. INSTALLATION OF PHOTOVOLTAIC SYSTEM AT
- 4 DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY HEADQUARTERS
- 5 BUILDING.
- 6 (a) In General.—The Administrator of General
- 7 Services shall install a photovoltaic system, as set forth

- 1 in the Sun Wall Design Project, for the headquarters
- 2 building of the Department of Energy located at 1000
- 3 Independence Avenue, Southwest, Washington, D.C., com-
- 4 monly known as the Forrestal Building.
- 5 (b) Funding.—There shall be available from the
- 6 Federal Buildings Fund established by section 592 of title
- 7 40, United States Code, \$30,000,000 to carry out this sec-
- 8 tion. Such sums shall be derived from the unobligated bal-
- 9 ance of amounts made available from the Fund for fiscal
- 10 year 2007, and prior fiscal years, for repairs and alter-
- 11 ations and other activities (excluding amounts made avail-
- 12 able for the energy program). Such sums shall remain
- 13 available until expended.
- 14 (c) Obligation of Funds.—None of the funds
- 15 made available pursuant to subsection (b) may be obli-
- 16 gated prior to September 30, 2007.
