COPYRIGHT REVISION BILL REPORTED FAVORABLY
BY THE COMMITTEE ON THE JUDICIARY OF THE
HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

On August 27, 1976, the Committee on the Judiciary of the House of Representatives reported favorably on S.22, the bill for general revision of the copyright law (title 17 of the United States Code) with an amendment in the nature of a substitute. Entitled "An Act" as passed by the Senate on February 19, 1976, S.22 was subsequently referred to the House Judiciary Committee's Subcommittee on Courts, Civil Liberties, and the Administration of Justice. This bill is substantially identical with the bill as reported on August 3, 1976 by the Subcommittee as an amendment in the nature of a substitute to S.22.
