

SUSAN B. ARAMAYO **APPOINTED** **CHIEF OF THE** **CATALOGING DIVISION**

Announcement

The Copyright Office announces that Susan B. Aramayo has been appointed Chief of the Cataloging Division effective April 20, 1981. She has been serving as Acting Chief of the Division since May 1980 and was formerly its Assistant Chief. Mrs. Aramayo has held varied administrative positions in the Copyright Office since 1977 when she joined the Office as Chief of the newly established Licensing Division. She brings an extensive knowledge of administrative and cataloging procedures to her new position.



After graduating cum laude from the University of Pittsburgh in 1963, Mrs. Aramayo earned a Master's degree in Library Science from the same institution in 1965. She joined the staff of the Descriptive Cataloging Division of the Library of Congress in 1965. In 1966 she was selected as one of the group of catalogers who initiated the Shared Cataloging Division. From 1967-1975 she was research assistant and later deputy chief instructor in the Cataloging Instruction Office.

As Educational Liaison Officer in the Office of the Assistant Librarian of Congress for Public Education (1975-77), Mrs. Aramayo coordinated and administered the Library's visitor program. She served as Vice President and President of the Library of Congress Professional Association in 1974 and 1975 and was on the Intern Committee in 1977 and 1979. She is a member of the American Library Association.
