

ANNOUNCEMENT

from the Copyright Office, Library of Congress, Washington, D.C. 20559

Copyright Office practices require that all elements necessary for registration, i.e., application, deposit(s), and fee, must be present in order for a claim to be considered for registration. We wish to advise you that deposit account submissions will be brought more in line with this policy. Registration and other service requests which are to be charged to a deposit account lacking sufficient funds to cover required fees will no longer necessarily be held until replenishment funds are received. Unless replenishment funds are received within 30 days from the date that any such materials are withheld, we will close the file on all such requests. In this event, any published deposits which may have been submitted will be made available for the use or disposition of the Library of Congress under the provisions of the Copyright Act (title 17, U. S. Code.) ss 407, 704(b); any unpublished deposit which may have been submitted will be returned. Documents for recordation will be returned.

If we close the file and registration is later sought, it will be necessary to submit a new application, deposit and fee. The effective date of registration will be based on the new later submission.

We wish to remind deposit account users that they are responsible for assuring that their account is adequately funded to cover all items submitted. Please remember to send replenishments only to the following address:
