Join your colleagues to hear from Roberta Shaffer, Law Librarian of Congress, on her ambitious plan to create the One World Law Library (OWLL) at the Library of Congress. OWLL will use the URL [Law.Gov](http://Law.Gov), as a central point of access for all primary source legal materials produced by federal agencies and entities and will involve strong federal collaborations. The Law Library is already working with the Government Printing Office (GPO), the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts and the American Association of Law Libraries' Federal Law Librarians' Caucus to collect information for the foundations of this exciting Web law resource.

During the Learning@Lunch program Shaffer will talk about the OWLL project's scope and timeline and outline the plan for various entities to contribute information under what is called the "National Legal Inventory."
