## IMPORTS AND EXPORTS OF FISHERY PRODUCTS ANNUAL SUMMARY, 2004

**IMPORTS.** U.S. imports of edible fishery products in 2004 were valued at \$11.3 billion, \$235.8 million more than in 2003. The quantity of edible imports was 2,245,671 metric tons, a 20,073 ton increase from the quantity imported in 2003.

The quantity of shrimp imported in 2004 was 517,617 tons, 13,123 tons more than the quantity imported in 2003. Valued at \$3.7 billion, shrimp imports accounted for 32 percent of the value of total edible imports. Imports of fresh and frozen salmon, including fillets, were 207,478 tons valued at \$974.2 million in 2004. Imports of fresh and frozen tuna were 184,788 tons, 24,618 tons less than imported in 2003. Imports of canned tuna were 201,078 tons, 7,136 tons less than in 2003. Imports of fresh and frozen fillets and steaks amounted to 484,942 tons, an increase of 34,511 tons from 2003. Regular and minced block imports were 61,435 tons, an increase of 2,763 tons from 2003. Edible imports consisted: of 1,848,344 tons of fresh and frozen products valued at \$9.9 billion; 338,076 tons of canned products valued at \$1.1 billion; 36,177 tons of cured products valued at \$172.3 million; 2,756 tons of caviar and roe products valued at \$33.9 million; and 20,318 tons of other products valued at \$86.3 million.

Imports of nonedible fishery products were valued at \$11.6 billion, \$1.4 billion more than imported in 2003. Total value of edible and nonedible products was \$22.9 billion in 2004, \$1.7 billion more than in 2003, when \$21.3 billion of fishery products were imported.

**EXPORTS.** U.S. exports of edible fishery products of domestic origin were 1,275,765 tons valued at \$3.5 billion, compared with 1,048,052 tons at \$3.1 billion exported in 2003.

Fresh and frozen items were 1,091,057 tons valued at \$2.7 billion, an increase of 200,789 tons and \$400.0 million compared with 2003. Fresh and frozen exports consisted principally of 106,674 tons of salmon valued at \$327.0 million, 25,643 tons of lobster (*Homarus* spp.) valued at \$307.3 million, and 200,965 tons of surimi valued at \$316.4 million. Canned items were 95,395 tons valued at \$259.8 million. Salmon was the major canned item exported, with 53,254 tons valued at \$175.5 million. Cured items were 3,939 tons valued at \$17.3 million. Caviar and roe exports were 55,659 tons valued at \$482.3 million. Other edible products accounted for 29,715 tons valued at \$58.1 million.

Exports of nonedible products were valued at \$8.6 billion. Exports of fish meal amounted to 140,722 tons valued at \$94.3 million. The total value of edible and nonedible exports was \$12.1 billion, \$1.3 billion more than in 2003.

**RE-EXPORTS.** U.S. exports of edible fishery products of foreign origin were 34,301 tons valued at \$210.3 million, compared to 38,634 tons valued at \$201.8 million re-exported in 2003. Fresh and frozen items were 29,297 tons valued at \$175.9 million a decrease of 1,680 tons but an increase of \$2.6 million compared with 2003. Fresh and frozen tuna was the principle product at 2,783 tons valued at \$32.0 million. Canned items accounted for 2,384 tons valued at \$9.0 million. Cured products were 667 tons valued at \$4.6 million. Caviar and roe re-exports were 974 tons valued at \$14.2 million. Other edible products were 979 tons valued at \$6.6 million.

Re-exports of nonedible fishery products were valued at \$1.3 billion. Fish oils accounted for 1,319 tons valued at \$3.3 million. The total value of edible and nonedible re-exports was \$1.5 billion, \$251.5 million more than in 2003.

**NOTES.** Unless otherwise noted, the information presented is based on U.S. Census Bureau data for the Customs territory of the United States. The territory includes the 50 states, District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands.

Imports for consumption are a combination of entries into the U.S. for immediate consumption and withdrawals from Customs bonded warehouses for consumption. These data reflect the actual entry into U.S. consumption channels of commodities that originated outside the United States.

Exports may include merchandise of both domestic and foreign origin. Census defines exports of "domestic" merchandise to include commodities, which are grown, produced, or manufactured in the United States. For statistical purposes, domestic exports also include commodities of foreign origin which have been changed in the U.S. from the form in which they were imported, or which have been enhanced in value by further manufacture in the United States.

Re-exports of "foreign" products are commodities which have entered the U.S. as imports and not sold, which, at the time of re-export, are in substantially the same condition as when imported. Items imported for sale in the U.S. but later resold overseas, however, are recorded as exports of domestic goods rather than as re-exports.

A product of foreign origin is transformed into a domestic good when the imported item loses its foreign identity through further substantial manufacture. This transformation generally produces a good with a different trade classification. For example, fish sticks cut from imported fish blocks, when exported to a foreign country, are classified as domestic for statistical purposes.

The value of imports presented is the "Customs value." It is based on the value of the product in the country of origin as appraised by the U.S. Customs and Border Protection, and excludes import duties, freight, insurance, and other charges incurred in bringing it to the United States. Export and re-export value is equivalent to f.a.s. (free alongside ship) at the port of export, based on the transaction price, including freight, insurance, and other charges incurred in placing the merchandise alongside the carrier. The value excludes the cost of loading, freight and subsequent insurance.
