21.30K1. Translators. [New]

One of the seven conditions in rule 21.30K1 for making an added entry for the translator of a work is that "the translation is important in its own right." The Library of Congress applies this condition as follows: Make an added entry under the heading for the translator of a work of belles lettres when the name of the translator appears on the chief source of information of the item being cataloged. (Note: This policy is effective January 1994.)

21.30M. Analytical entries. [Rev.]

Added Entries for Works

Added entries for works reflect the type of main entry heading of the work being cataloged in the tracing as follows:

<i>Type of main entry</i>	<i>Type of added entry</i>
Personal or corporate name heading	Name heading/uniform title
Title	Uniform title
Uniform title (e.g., Bible)	Uniform title

The phrase "added entries for works" in these instructions is intended to encompass all the various types of added entries listed above.

Added entries for works are of two types: analytical and simple. They are made on the basis of various rules, some of which prescribe an analytical added entry in explicit terms, others of which do not. Whenever the added entry is made to furnish an access point to work contained in the item being cataloged, it should be an analytical added entry (e.g., 21.7B1, 21.13B1, 21.19A1). If the added entry serves only to provide an approach to the item being cataloged through a related work, however, and the text of this work is not present in the item being cataloged, then a simple added entry for the work is appropriate (e.g., 21.12B1, 21.28B1, 21.30G1).

The relationship that is expressed between works by means of an added entry, either analytical or simple, is limited to a single access point, namely, that of the main entry. An added entry in the form of the main entry heading for a work provides the sole access to the work it represents in the tracing on the catalog record for another work; do not trace in addition any added entries for that work's title (when main entry is under a name heading), joint author, editor, compiler, translator, etc.

Analytical Added Entries

Formulate analytical added entries as follows:

<i>Type of analytical added entry</i>	<i>Components</i>
Name heading/title	Heading in catalog-entry form plus uniform title
Title	Uniform title
Uniform title (e.g., Bible)	Uniform title

In addition, following the uniform title, provide the language (if appropriate). For the Bible and the collective uniform titles "Works" and "Selections," provide the elements appropriate to these uniform titles as called for in the relevant rules and LCRI: for the Bible, 25.18A; for "Works," LCRI 25.8; for "Selections," LCRI 25.9. Note that all of these specify including in the uniform title the year of publication of the item being cataloged.

In making analytical added entries, note especially the following details:

- 1) Do not abbreviate the names of languages.
- 2) For the Bible and the collective uniform titles noted above that include the year of publication, formulate the year according to the guideline stated in LCRI 25.8.
- 3) Do not enclose uniform titles within brackets.
- 4) Do not give in the tracing a title found in the item being cataloged that is different from the uniform title.

Simple Added Entries

Formulate simple added entries as follows:

<i>Type of simple added entry</i>	<i>Components</i>
Name heading/title	Heading in catalog-entry form plus uniform title
Title	Uniform title
Uniform title (e.g., Beowulf)	Uniform title

Note that subject entries for works are formulated in the same manner as simple added entries.

23.2. GENERAL RULES. [Rev.]

Sources

Apply the following for current place names:

- 1) For names in the United States, base the heading on the form found in a recent edition of the *Rand McNally Commercial Atlas and Marketing Guide*.
- 2) For names in Great Britain, Australia, and New Zealand, base the heading on the form found in a recently published gazetteer.
- 3) For names in Canada, use the heading provided by the National Library of Canada. Accept the NLC form, even if it differs from LC policy in such matters as abbreviations, fullness, qualifiers, etc.
- 4) For other names, base the heading either on the form found in the work being cataloged together with a consideration of the form found in a recently published gazetteer or on the form provided by the United States Board on Geographic Names (BGN), as necessary. This means that BGN *may* be consulted routinely or not, as efficiency, etc., in the particular case warrants. It also means that all problems not resolved by the work in hand and a recently published gazetteer *must* be referred to BGN.

English or Vernacular Forms

If BGN approves both a vernacular and an English form (called a conventional name in BGN terminology), use the English form.

For the following names, use the English form listed rather than the BGN-approved form:

Note: If a foreign name is established in an English form, use the same form if the name is used by more than one jurisdictional level or is used as part of another name, whenever the same name occurs at the beginning of the name.

Modifications of the Name

1) *Initial articles.* Drop initial articles from the beginning of the entry element of geographic names in Arabic, Urdu, Hebrew, and Yiddish. Retain initial articles in other non-English geographic names when retention is supported by current gazetteers in the country's language. ("Non-English" is meant to include names in French, Spanish, etc., when these are used in the United States (e.g., Los Angeles) or other English-speaking countries.) Drop all other initial articles (e.g., drop "The" from "The Dalles").

2) *Gazetteers.* If the name is based on the form found in a recently published gazetteer, generally use in the heading the form found on the item being cataloged rather than a shortened form or unabbreviated form found in a gazetteer, unless 23.5A is applicable. However, for "Saint" or "St." and "Mount" or "Mt.," always use the spelled out form regardless of the item being cataloged or other evidence.

in source: Montgomery County
gazetteer: Montgomery
heading: **Montgomery County (Md.)**

in source: St. Joseph
gazetteer: Saint Joseph
heading: **Saint Joseph (Mo.)**

3) *U.S. Board on Geographic Names.* If BGN approves a romanized form that conflicts with LC's policy for the romanization of that language, use the LC form of romanization in the heading. If the BGN response indicates both a brief and a long form of the place name, generally select the long form as the heading, unless 23.5A is applicable.

BGN: Borno [brief] State
heading: **Borno State (Nigeria)**

BGN: Coast [brief] Province
heading: **Coast Province (Kenya)**

BGN: Sulzbach [brief] am Neckar
heading: **Sulzbach am Neckar (Germany)**

BGN: Vailly [brief]-sur-Sauldre
heading: **Vailly-sur-Sauldre (France)**

BGN: Kōra [brief]-chō
heading: **Kōra-chō (Japan)**

Note that in the case of conflicts 23.4F1 mandates a preference for long forms found in sources (including BGN "variants"), rather than adding "an appropriate smaller place" within parentheses after the conflicting name.

BGN: Münster
sources: Münster in Westfalen
heading: **Münster in Westfalen (Germany)**
not Münster (North Rhine-Westphalia, Germany)

but BGN: Sundern
sources: Sundern (Sauerland)
heading: **Sundern (Hochsauerlandkreis, Germany)**

4) *Districts of India.* In order to have consistent headings for the districts of India, establish all of them with the word "District" (or its equivalent in non-English) omitted. If the resulting heading conflicts, as in the case of the city's bearing the same name, add "District" as an element of the parenthetical qualifier (24.6).

5) *U.S. Townships.* For U.S. townships (called "towns" in some states) that encompass one or more local communities and the surrounding territory, do not include the term "township" or "town" as part of the name. Instead, add the term after the name of the state.

Kintire (Minn. : Township)
Milo (Me. : Town)

These non-local jurisdictions are called "townships" in Arkansas, California, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, New Jersey, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Pennsylvania, and South Dakota; they are called "towns" in Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New York, Rhode Island, Vermont, and Wisconsin. (Consult Andriot's *Township Atlas of the United States* to determine if there is more than one township with the same name in the same state; if there is more than one, apply LCRI 23.4F1.)

Note: For the period 1980-1990, the term "Township" or "Town" was added only if the name conflicted. Change existing headings for U.S. townships lacking the term "Township" or "Town" when the headings are needed for post-1990 cataloging.

Special Decisions

1) *China.* For all the governments that have controlled the mainland of China, use "China" for all periods except 1931-1945. For the government headquartered in Nanking, 1931-1937, and in Chungking, 1937-1945, use "China." For the government headquartered in Jui-chin, 1931-1937, use "China (Soviet Republic, 1931-1937)." For the government headquartered in Peking, 1937-1940, use "China (Provisional government, 1937-1940)." For the governments headquartered in Nanking, 1938-1945, use "China (Reformed government, 1938-1940)" for 1938-1940, and use "China (National government, 1940-1945)" for 1940-1945. For the post-1948 government on Taiwan, use "China (Republic : 1949-)." For the province of Taiwan, use "Taiwan."

2) *Germany.* For the Federal Republic of Germany, use "Germany (West)" for 1949-1990 and "Germany" after 1990. For the German Democratic Republic, use "Germany (East)."

3) *Great Britain*. For the United Kingdom, use "Great Britain."

4) *Korea*. For Korea until September 1945, including the Japanese occupation (1910-1945), use "Korea." For Nam Chosŏn Kwado Chŏngbu (South Korean Interim Government, 1947-1948), the American occupation government (1945-1948), and the republic of Korea, use "Korea (South)." For the Soviet occupation government (1945-1948) and the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, use "Korea (North)."

5) *London*. In dealing with London, use the following headings:

a) Use "Corporation of London" for items from the entity bearing this name that has administrative control over the 677-acre City of London.

b) Use "Greater London Council" for items from the former entity bearing this name that had administrative control over the 32 London boroughs that made up "Greater London" (excluding the City of London). (The entity ceased April 1, 1986.)

c) Use "London (England)" as the qualifier added to corporate headings for a body located in the City of London or in an inner borough. Use "London (England)" also as the qualifier added to a corporate heading for a body located in an outer borough when the body is commonly associated with London rather than with the name of the particular outer borough. Otherwise, use the heading for the particular outer borough. (The inner London boroughs are Camden, Greenwich, Hackney, Hammersmith and Fulham, Islington, Kensington and Chelsea, Lambeth, Lewisham, Southwark, Tower Hamlets, Wandsworth, and the City of Westminster.)

6) *Soviet Union*. For the former Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, use "Soviet Union."

7) *Washington, D.C.* For Washington, D.C., use "District of Columbia" as the heading for the government of this name. Use "Washington (D.C.)" only as a location qualifier or as the entry element for cross references from place.

23.4F1. Further additions. [Rev.]

Conflicts

Apply either 23.4F1 or 24.6 (depending on the situation) to resolve conflicts in headings for places (geographic names and names of governments) not already resolved by the additions called for by 23.4C-23.4E. Conflict in place names is not restricted to those already established or being established in the catalog (the file against which the searching and cataloging is being done). Instead, if there is no existing conflict in the catalog, search gazetteers, etc., to determine if two or more places within the same jurisdiction have the same name or if two or more places with the same name would bear the same qualifier for

the larger place.

U.S. Townships

If a name of a U.S. township (called "towns" in some states) conflicts with the name of another township within the same state, add the heading for the county to each name before the term "Township" or "Town." (Consult Andriot's *Township Atlas of the United States* to determine if there is more than one township with the same name in the same state.)

Spring (Berks County, Pa. : Township)
Spring (Centre County, Pa. : Township)

Hawaii

If local places in Hawaii conflict, add to each name the heading for the island on which the place is located rather than the heading for the county.

25.8. COMPLETE WORKS. [Rev.]

The collective uniform title "Works" is used frequently enough to make it advisable to use additions for the purposes of making these collective titles distinct, of insuring that translations file after editions in the original language, and of distinguishing between two or more editions published in the same year. To achieve these objectives, apply the following when using "Works":

1) When an item is first cataloged, add the date of publication of the edition at the end of the uniform title. (If a multipart item is incomplete, give the earliest date known. If an item being added to the set was published earlier than the date given in the uniform title, do not change the date in the uniform title until the set is complete.) Reduce the publication date to a simple four digit form that most nearly represents the publication date (of the first volume or part if more than one) given in the publication, distribution, etc., area. Convert a hyphen to a zero.

Add the date in all cases, including translations. When making a reference from the title proper of the item (25.2E2), add the date at the end of the title proper in all cases.

2) If two editions bear the same publication date *and* it becomes necessary to refer to a particular edition in a secondary entry, add the publisher's name after the publication date in the most succinct but intelligible form. Make this addition to the uniform title of the edition(s) needing to be distinguished for secondary entry. Make changes to existing records as appropriate to insure that all iterations of a particular title, including those on

series authority records, are the same. If different editions are published in the same year by the same publisher, add an appropriate qualification to the publisher's name.

If a person has written both musical and literary works, apply the following:

- 1) If the person is primarily a composer, use the uniform title "Works"
 - a) for editions containing the complete musical and literary works and
 - b) for editions containing the complete musical works.

(For complete collections of the literary works alone, use the uniform title "Literary works."
For partial collections of the literary works, see LCRI 25.10.)

- 2) If the person is primarily a writer, use the uniform title "Works"

- a) for editions containing the complete literary and musical works and
- b) for editions containing the complete literary works.

(For complete collections of the musical works, use the uniform title "Musical works." For partial collections of the musical works, see LCRI 25.10.)

25.30B6. Instrumental music for orchestra, string orchestra, band. [New]

In the 1988 revision of AACR 2, incorrect language was inadvertently introduced into the first sentence of this rule. The sentence should read as follows:

RARE BOOKS

From 1989-1991 Library of Congress staff and the Bibliographic Standards Committee of the ALA/ACRL Rare Books and Manuscripts Section collaborated on the revision of the descriptive cataloging rules for rare books to produce *Descriptive Cataloging of Rare Books* (Library of Congress, 1991). The Library's Cataloging Policy and Support Office and the Bibliographic Standards Committee have agreed that the committee will assume responsibility for soliciting queries, corrections, and revisions to DCRB. Queries will be evaluated by the committee and forwarded to CPSO as appropriate. Changes will be published in *Cataloging Service Bulletin*.

MUSIC CATALOGING DECISIONS

1.6H. Subseries.

The Library of Congress classifies collected works of composers (Gesamtausgaben) as collected sets in M3. Many such publications are divided into subseries by medium of performance or genre, and individual volumes are numbered only within each subseries. In such cases LCRI 1.6H requires that each subseries be established separately (cf. the "Progress in nuclear energy" example on p. 2 of LCRI 1.6H). This would preclude making a collected set record for the set as a whole and would therefore require classifying each subseries according to its content (Piano music in M22, Operas in M1500, etc.). To avoid this the Cataloging Policy and Support Office has authorized the following deviation from LCRI 1.6H for access points for music Gesamtausgaben.

For Gesamtausgaben that are issued in numbered (or alphabetically designated) subseries, with individual volumes numbered only within the subseries, make only one series authority record and only one collected-set bibliographic record—for the set as a whole. In bibliographic records for analyzed volumes (cf. MCD 13.3), transcribe series statements as instructed in the LCRI, but in series added entries omit the subseries title and

consider the numerical designation of the subseries to be part of the series numbering. Include an explanatory note in the series authority record.

series statement: (Neue Ausgabe sämtlicher Werke. Serie II, Messen, Passionen, oratorische Werke / Johann Sebastian Bach ; Bd. 8)

series authority record: Bach, Johann Sebastian, 1685-1750. Works. 1954

note (667) in SAR: Issued in 9 numbered "Serien." Do not include the title of the "Serie" in the series tracing, but include the number of the "Serie" in the series numbering

series tracing: Bach, Johann Sebastian, 1685-1750. Works. 1954 ; Ser. 2, Bd. 8

In contents notes in collected-set records for Gesamtausgaben treated in this way, list only the numerical designations and the titles of the subseries, not the numbers and titles of individual volumes.

Contents: Ser. 1. Kantaten -- Ser. 2. Messen, Passionen, oratorische Werke ...

SUBJECT CATALOGING

SUBDIVISION SIMPLIFICATION PROGRESS

Since the Subject Subdivisions Conference took place at Airlie House, Virginia, in May 1991, progress continues to be made in simplifying subdivisions in the Library of Congress Subject Headings system. On Weekly Lists 93-23 to 93-41, changes were made in the following areas:

Recommendation #1. Toward achieving the recommended standard order of [topic]—[place]—[chronology]—[form] in LC subject heading strings, new topical subdivisions for which geographic orientation is logical are now established with the designation (*May Subd Geog*). On a case-by-case basis, subdivisions not previously divided by place are being authorized for geographic subdivision. Over 330 subdivisions not previously divided by place, including 160 free-floating subdivisions listed below, were authorized for geographic subdivision during this period.

Recommendation #6. During this period, progress in simplifying subdivisions was made in the following areas:

1) *Cancellation of subdivisions that represent the same or similar concepts in different forms*

The subdivision —**Appliances, utensils, etc.**, established under the heading **Confectionery**, was cancelled and replaced by the existing general free-floating subdivision —**Equipment and supplies**.

The subdivision —**Athletics**, used under names of individual educational institutions, was replaced by the subdivision —**Sports**, which is free-floating under ethnic groups. The subdivisions —**History—Revolution, 1775-1783** and —**History—Civil War, 1861-1865**, which were free-floating under names of individual educational institutions, were replaced by the existing free-floating subdivisions, —**History—18th century** and —**History—19th century**.

The subdivision —**Costume and adornment**, used under groups of Indians, was replaced by the subdivision, —**Costume**, which is free-floating under ethnic groups.

The obsolete subdivision —**Curiosa and miscellany**, which was established under the heading **Earth**, was cancelled and replaced with the standard free-floating subdivision —**Miscellanea**.

The subdivision —**Diseases—Vaccination**, used under individual animals and groups of animals, was replaced by use of the subdivision —**Vaccination**, which is used under individual diseases. The subdivision —**Psychology—Testing**, used under individual animals and groups of animals, was discontinued in favor of —**Psychological testing**, which is free-floating under classes of persons and ethnic groups.

The subdivision —**Maps—To 1800**, used under names of places and topical headings, and the subdivision —**Geography—Maps—To 1800**, used under sacred works, were replaced by —**Maps—Early works to 1800** and —**Geography—Maps—Early works to 1800**. The subdivision —**Early works to 1800** is a general free-floating subdivision.

2) *Elimination of exceptional practices*

Four subdivisions on the list of free-floating subdivisions used under names of places (H 1140) were discontinued in favor of dividing the corresponding main headings by place. The latter represents the standard order for topical headings.

Three subdivisions on the list of free-floating subdivisions used under names of bodies of water (H 1145.5) were discontinued in favor of dividing the corresponding main headings by place.

3) *Subdivisions replaced by phrase headings*

Over forty subdivisions, including fifteen formerly free-floating subdivisions listed below, were cancelled and replaced by phrase headings. The subdivision —**Accidents and injuries**, which was free-floating under headings for sports, games, and exercises, was replaced by headings of the type: **Aerobics injuries**; **Aquatic sports injuries**; **Boating accidents**; **Boating injuries**. Other examples of changes are: **Accounting—Books of accounts** changed to **Account books**; **Aeronautics, Military—Observations** changed to **Aerial observation** (**Military science**); **Magnetic recorders and recording—Cassette recorders** changed to **Cassette tape recorders**; **Postal service—Certified mail** changed to **Certified mail**; **Prisons—Visits and correspondence with inmates** changed to **Prison visits and Prisoners—Correspondence**.

4) *Subdivisions updated to more current forms*

Nine subdivisions were uninverted or updated to more current forms:

5) Subdivisions no longer needed

Six subdivisions determined to be no longer needed were cancelled.

The subdivision —**Antiquity**, which was established under the heading **Authors and publishers**, was cancelled in favor of the unsubdivided heading.

The subdivision —**Biography—London life**, which was established under **Shakespeare, William, 1564-1616**, was cancelled in favor of using —**Biography**.

The subdivision —**Circus collections**, which had been free-floating under names of individual persons, families, and corporate bodies, was cancelled in favor of using the general heading **Circus—Collectibles—Private collections**.

The subdivision —**Curious devices**, which was established under **Machinery**, was discontinued in favor of the unsubdivided heading.

The subdivision —**Intramural games**, which was free-floating under headings for sports, was discontinued. The general heading **Intramural games** will be combined with the heading for the individual sport.

The subdivision —**Kidnapping**, established under the heading **Slaves**, was cancelled. The general heading **Kidnapping** will be assigned with the heading **Slaves**.

As part of the simplification of documentation on free-floating subdivisions, two lists of free-floating subdivisions used under pattern headings were merged for the *1993 Update Number 2* to the *Subject Cataloging Manual: Subject Headings*, which was distributed during the fall. The list of subdivisions used under domestic animals, H 1148, was discontinued in favor of H 1147, the list of subdivisions used under animals in general. Unique subdivision on H 1148 were added to H 1147, which was renamed *Animals*. Two pattern headings now represent the category, **Fishes and Cattle**. Subdivisions needing explanation or having limited use are explained in footnotes.

DESCRIPTION AND TRAVEL

In 1991, the Subject Subdivisions Conference at Airlie House, Virginia, recommended that chronological subdivisions relating to date of issue be eliminated. This recommendation has caused LC to examine several cases where subdivisions of this type have been used, including headings of the type [place]—Description and travel—[chronological subdivision]

In December 1992, the Cataloging Policy and Support Office requested opinions in a survey distributed to LC catalogers and libraries involved in cooperative cataloging efforts with LC. Two options for treatment of this material were given. The first option would discontinue chronological subdivisions after [place]—Description and travel; the second option would allow chronological subdivisions in selected cases, by revising the subdivisions and assigning the subdivisions to represent the content of the work, not the date of issue.

Both options had advantages and disadvantages that were explained in the survey. Nearly two-thirds of the respondents favored the first option, elimination of chronological subdivisions after [place]—Description and travel. CPSO began the cancellation of these subdivisions in February 1993 and completed the work in October 1993.

In coordination with the cancellation of these subdivisions, policies were revised to allow the use of the subdivision —Early works to 1800 after —Description and travel. Catalogers were also provided with the option of expressing the chronological content of the item by assigning an additional heading such as [place]—History—[chronological subdivision].

[TOPIC] IN LITERATURE; THE SUBDIVISION —IN LITERATURE

One category of subject headings that LC has traditionally assigned according to pattern rather than authority has been topical headings that include the free-floating phrase ... in literature. In response to a recommendation from the ALA/CCS/ALCTS Subject Analysis Committee (SAC), LC has agreed to begin creating authority records for headings of the type: [topic] in literature, e.g., *Butterflies in literature*, *Marriage in literature*. The phrase ... in literature is no longer free-floating. Establishing these headings will

provide explicit authority records for systems that rely on machine validation and will make it easier for libraries performing copy cataloging to validate these headings.

The newly authorized free-floating subdivision —**In literature** has replaced the phrase ... **in fiction, drama, poetry, etc.**, previously used with names of individual persons, and the phrase ... **in literature** when used with names of places and corporate bodies. The subdivision —**In literature** is now used under headings for names of places, individual persons, families, corporate bodies, and sacred works, e.g., **San Francisco (Calif.)—In literature**; **Lincoln, Abraham, 1809-1865—In literature**; **Roosevelt family—In literature**; **Baltimore Orioles (Baseball team)—In literature**; **Bible—In literature**. This change means that subject headings for the treatment of places, persons, families, corporate bodies, and sacred works in literature will retain the same tag as the basic headings for those entities as subjects. This practice also parallels that now used for works about the portrayal of special subjects on postage stamps where headings of the type [**topic**] **on postage stamps** are established for works about the portrayal of specific topics, and headings of the type [...]—**On postage stamps** are used for works about the portrayal of entities tagged 100, 110, 130, or 151 in authority records.

A project is underway to create authority records for existing topical headings constructed with the phrase ... **in literature** that have been used on records in the LC MARC database and to change personal, corporate, and geographic headings with the added phrases ... **in fiction, drama, poetry, etc.** or ... **in literature** to a form using the free-floating subdivision —**In literature**. Authority records for new occurrences of a topical heading using the phrase ... **in literature** are being made as they are needed for current cataloging.
