TO: Printing and Publishing Officials of the Federal Government

SUBJECT: Rider Orders for the Paper Edition of the *Code of Federal Regulations (CFR)*, Titles 17 through 27, revised April 1, 2012.

The Office of the Federal Register (OFR) has issued a letter to agency Requisition Officer announcing the opportunity to submit rider orders for the paper edition of the code of Federal Regulation (CFR), Titles 17 through 27, revised April 1, 2012. We are distributing the information by Circular Letter to help ensure that agencies receive this information in a timely manner.

Please note that your requisitions (SF-1s) for the above products are due to the Government Printing Office (GPO) no later than **MAY 4, 2012**. Be sure to indicate the number of copies needed for all of the activities in your organization and include the OFR requisition number (**NARA12GPO-NF00002**), the correct **Billing Address Code (BAC) for your bureau/office** and the appropriate **GPO jacket numbers** (see enclosed list) on your requisitions. Individual SF-1's are required for each Jacket number and its correlating Title.

Please note that GPO will make every effort to include any orders (SF-1's) received after the October 28 deadline in the original printing at rider rate pricing. However, due to the CFR production processes and schedules, orders received late may be directed to the Superintendent of Documents for fulfillment at the higher post-production sales rates.
