UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENT

Eric H. Holder, Jr. (Cal. No. 9)

Ordered, That at 3:15 p.m. on Monday, February 2, 2009, the Senate proceed to executive session to consider the nomination of Eric H. Holder, Jr., of the District of Columbia, to be Attorney General; that there be three hours of debate with respect to the nomination, with the time equally divided and controlled between the Chairman and the Ranking Member of the Committee on the Judiciary, or their designees; that at 6:15 p.m., the Senate proceed to vote on confirmation of the nomination; that upon confirmation, the motion to reconsider be laid upon the table; that no further motions be in order; the President be immediately notified of the Senate's action and the Senate resume legislative session.
