WORK HANDLED BY UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES
DURING FISCAL YEAR 1974

CRIMINAL CASES

FILED - Criminal filings amounting to 43,319 showed a decrease of 3339 or 7.17 percent from the number filed in the previous fiscal year. 79.66 percent of the total was in 17 offenses having 700 or more cases; 10 showed increases while 7 showed decreases. Increases occurred in Weapons Control (2546 to 2818), Income Tax (1419 to 1451), Bank Robbery (1974 to 2028), Frauds vs./Government (2473 to 2818), Postal Crimes (3193 to 3243), while Narcotics (9755 to 8567), Selective Service (3490 to 1437), and National Motor Vehicle Act (2291 to 2078), showed decreases. Increases took place in 36 districts ranging from 1 in Arkansas Eastern to 497 in California Southern. Decreases took place in 57 districts ranging from 3 in Arkansas Western to 1092 in The District of Columbia.

TERMINATED - Cases terminated decreased 3598 or 7.52 percent under the previous year's total. Of the total or 44,255 closed, 25,354 involving 32,332 defendants were pleas of guilty, 3927 (involving 5493 defendants) were found guilty after trial and 1201 (involving 2043 defendants) were found not guilty (including 16 not guilty verdicts by reason insanity).

PENDING - With 27,644 cases, the pending caseload showed a decrease of 3.28 percent under the 28,580* cases pending at the close of fiscal year 1973. Of the pending cases, 12,242 cases were awaiting arraignment in court or trial, while 1685 were awaiting sentence. 7691 are fugitives and 377 in other status beyond the control of the United States Attorneys.

GRAND JURY PROCEEDINGS

Grand Jury proceedings, comprised of 25,595 indictments and 191 No True Bills, amounted to 25,786 a decrease of 14.72 percent under the previous fiscal year.

CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS

RECEIVED - Complaints received decreased to 170,865; this is 4.30 percent less than the 178,526 received in fiscal year 1973. California Southern with 26,387 had the most complaints and California Central with 7,410 and Illinois Northern with 4,957 were the next highest. 89,912 of the complaints were in eleven offenses as shown below:

PENDING - Criminal Complaints pending as of June 30, 1974 dropped to 28,122 a decrease of 1,135 or 3.88 percent less than the 29,257 pending as of June 30, 1973.

CLOSED - 122,466 Complaints were closed during 1974 without reaching court dockets. Of this number 102,535 or 83.73 percent of the total were closed by declination of prosecution.

CIVIL CASES

FILED - Civil Cases filed amounted to 33,067 a decrease of 1,494 or 4.34 percent less than the previous year's total. 35 districts had increases and 59 districts showed decreases from the previous year. 13,816 or 41.78 percent of the total was in fifteen districts having filings ranging from 603 to 1,316, Tax Lien cases with 4,331, Tort cases with 2,174 and General Claims cases with 2,289 had 13.10, 6.57 and 6.92 percent respectively of the cases filed.

TERMINATED - With 37 districts showing increases and 57 districts with decreases, civil cases terminated decreased to 30,998. This total is under fiscal year 1973 total by 1,923 or 5.85 percent.

4,880 of these cases were suits in which the government as defendant was sued for \$183,276,540. 618 of them involving \$62,339,079 were closed by compromise amounting to \$49,613,043 and 1037 involving \$34,548,871 resulting in judgments against the

government amounting to \$25,409,987. The remaining 3,225 cases involving \$88,388,590 were won by the government, thus bringing the savings to \$108,253,510 a decrease of \$108,069,489 or 49.96 percent from the \$216,322,999 saved in Fiscal Year 1973.

PENDING - Civil cases pending as of the close of the fiscal year increased by 2,609 or 6.08 percent to 36,088: 14,277 or 39.56 percent of the caseload was in twelve districts with case-loads ranging from 731 in Pennsylvania Eastern to 2,266 in New York Eastern. Tax Lien cases with 6,011 increased to 16.66 percent of the total as compared to 5,367 or 15.93 percent of the total pending as of June 30, 1973. Land cases with 1,915 or 5.31 percent decreased from 1,940 or 5.76 percent of the total.

CIVIL MATIERS

RECEIVED - Civil Matters received amounted to 40,996, an increase of 628 or 1.55 percent more than the 40,368 in Fiscal Year 1973. Tax Lien matters with 4,466 and Tort matters with 2,352 comprised 10.89 percent and 5.74 percent respectively of the total. Delegated General Claims matters amounted to 4,184 or 10.21 percent of the total. 14,427 or 35.19 percent of the total was in twelve districts having totals ranging from 870 in Georgia Northern to 1,724 in California Central.

TERMINATED - Civil matters terminated without reaching court dockets amounted to 5,059 a decrease of 2,645 or 34.33 percent less than the fiscal year 1973 total of 7,704.

PENDING - 10,842 civil matters were pending as of June 30, 1974 as compared to 10,157 as of June 30, 1973. This is an increase of 648 or 6.74 percent.

MAN-HOURS

A total of 464,124 man-hours were spent in court during Fiscal Year 1974. This is an increase of 53,111 or 12.92 percent over Fiscal Year 1973. Following is a breakdown of those hours:

Based on an average employment of 1,256.9 each Assistant United States Attorney averaged 36.92 hours per month in courtroom work during the fiscal year. This compares with an averaged 38.8 hours per month in Fiscal Year 1973.

COLLECTIONS

Collections for Fiscal Year 1974 amounted to \$157,807,013, an increase of \$21,996,021 or 16.19 percent more than the \$135,810,992 collected in Fiscal Year 1973.

PERSONNEL

During the year United States Attorneys' employment averaged 2,740 employees and 2,838 were on the rolls as of June 30, 1974. Cases handled per Assistant United States Attorney decreased from 134.9 in Fiscal Year 1973 to 110.5 in the current year while cases terminated decreased from 76.3 to 59.8.

Cases Pending in United States Attorneys' Offices

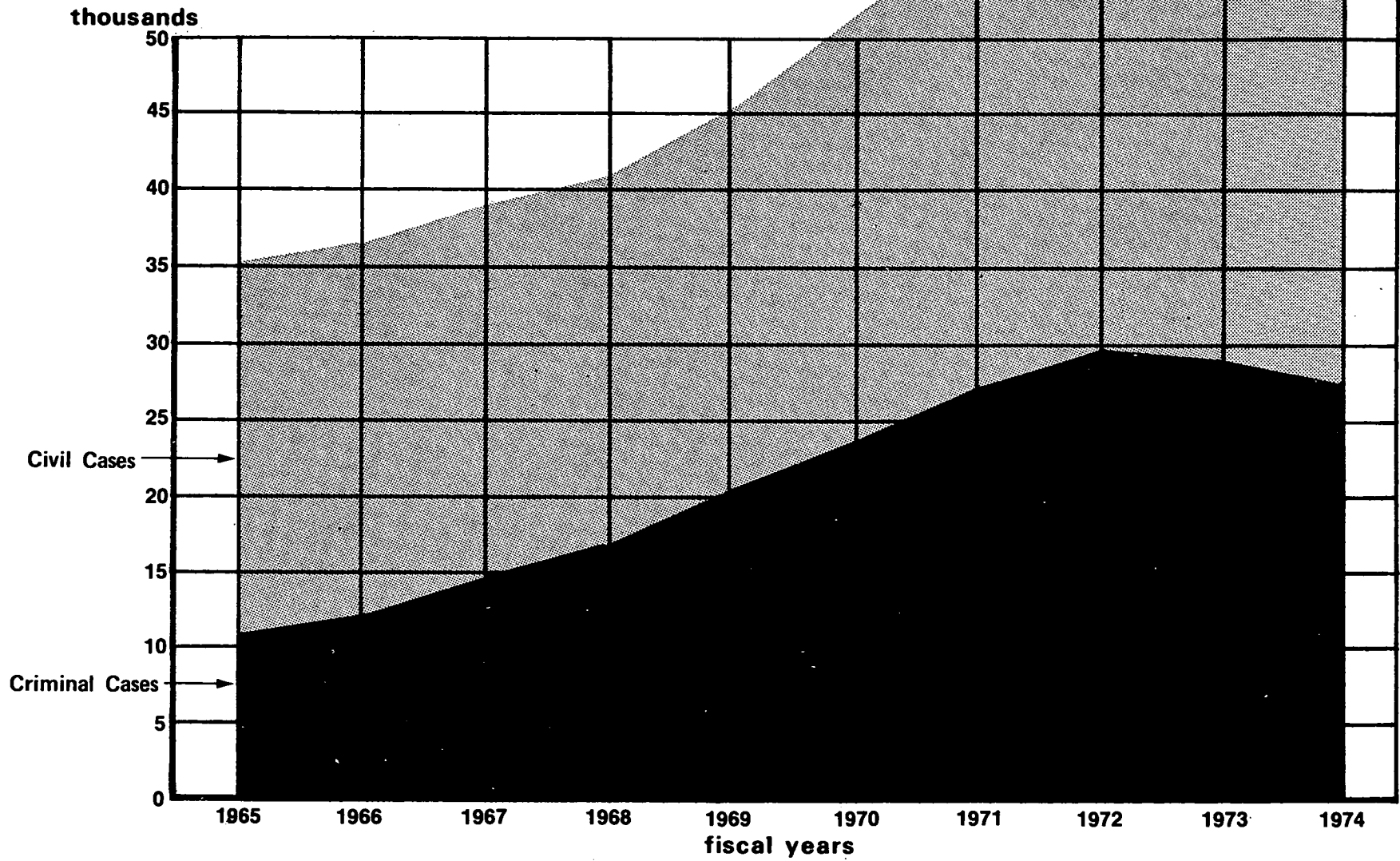

Criminal and Civil Cases Filed in United States Attorneys' Offices

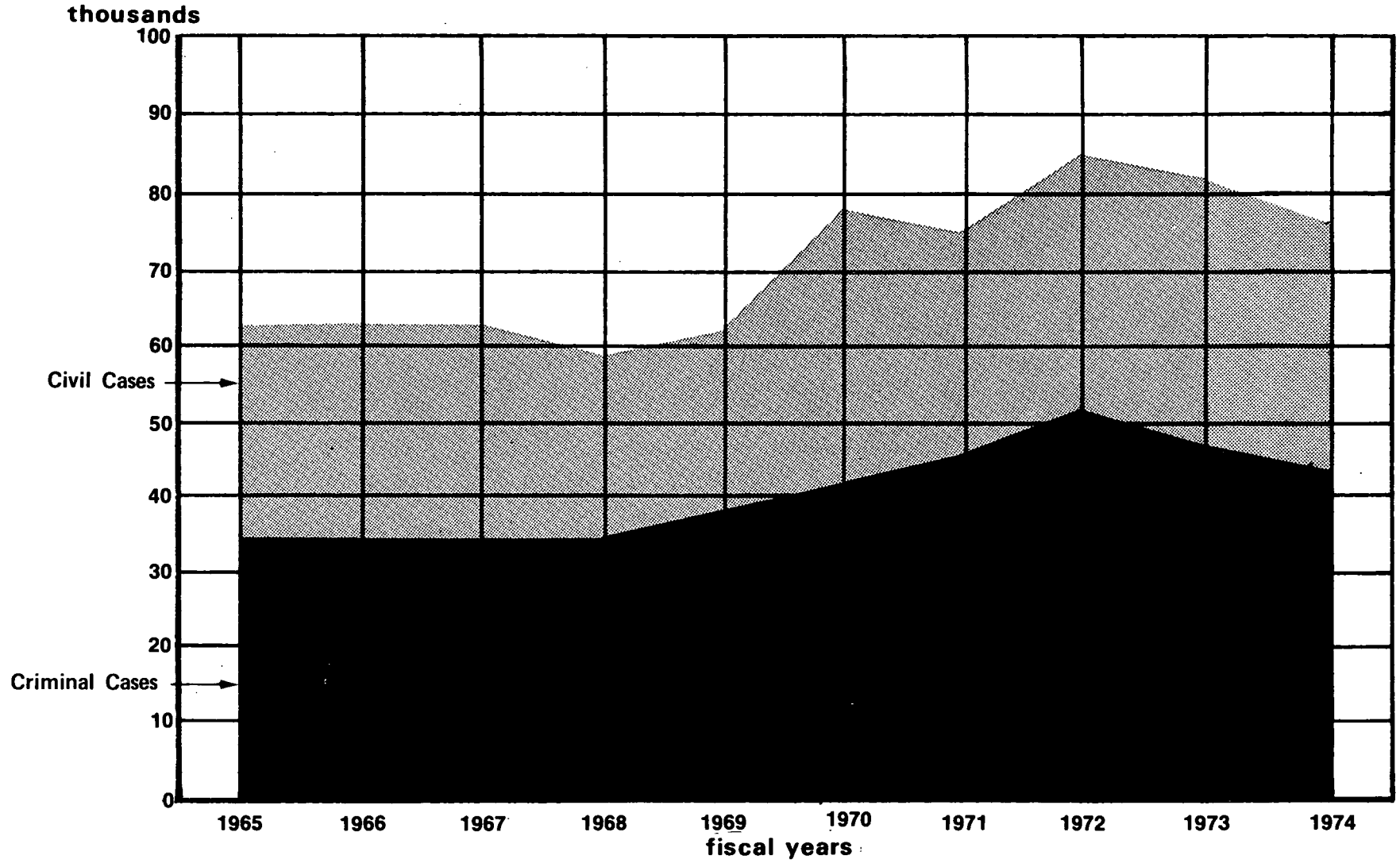

United States Attorneys' Offices**

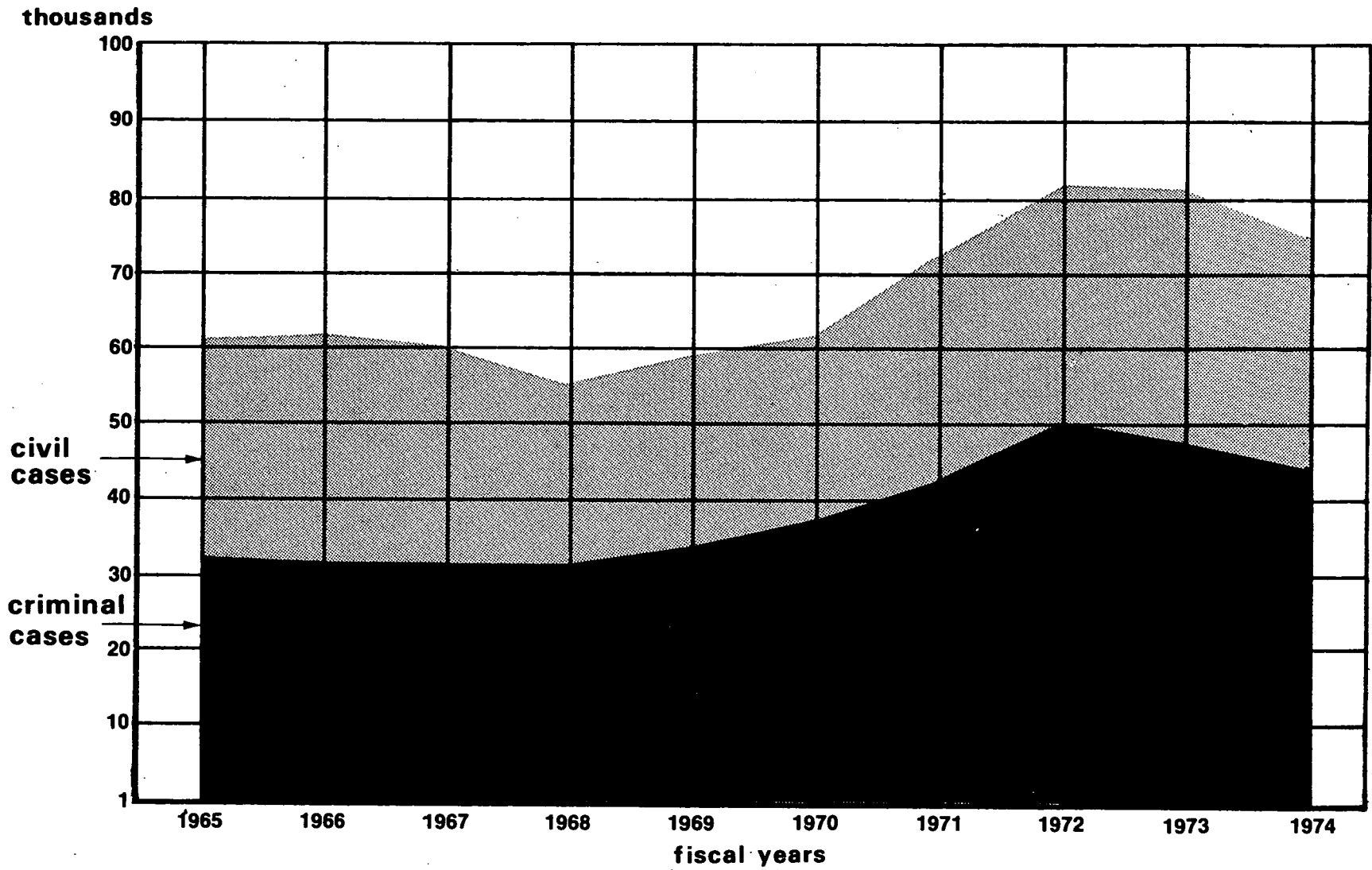

Criminal and Civil Matters Received in United States Attorneys' Offices

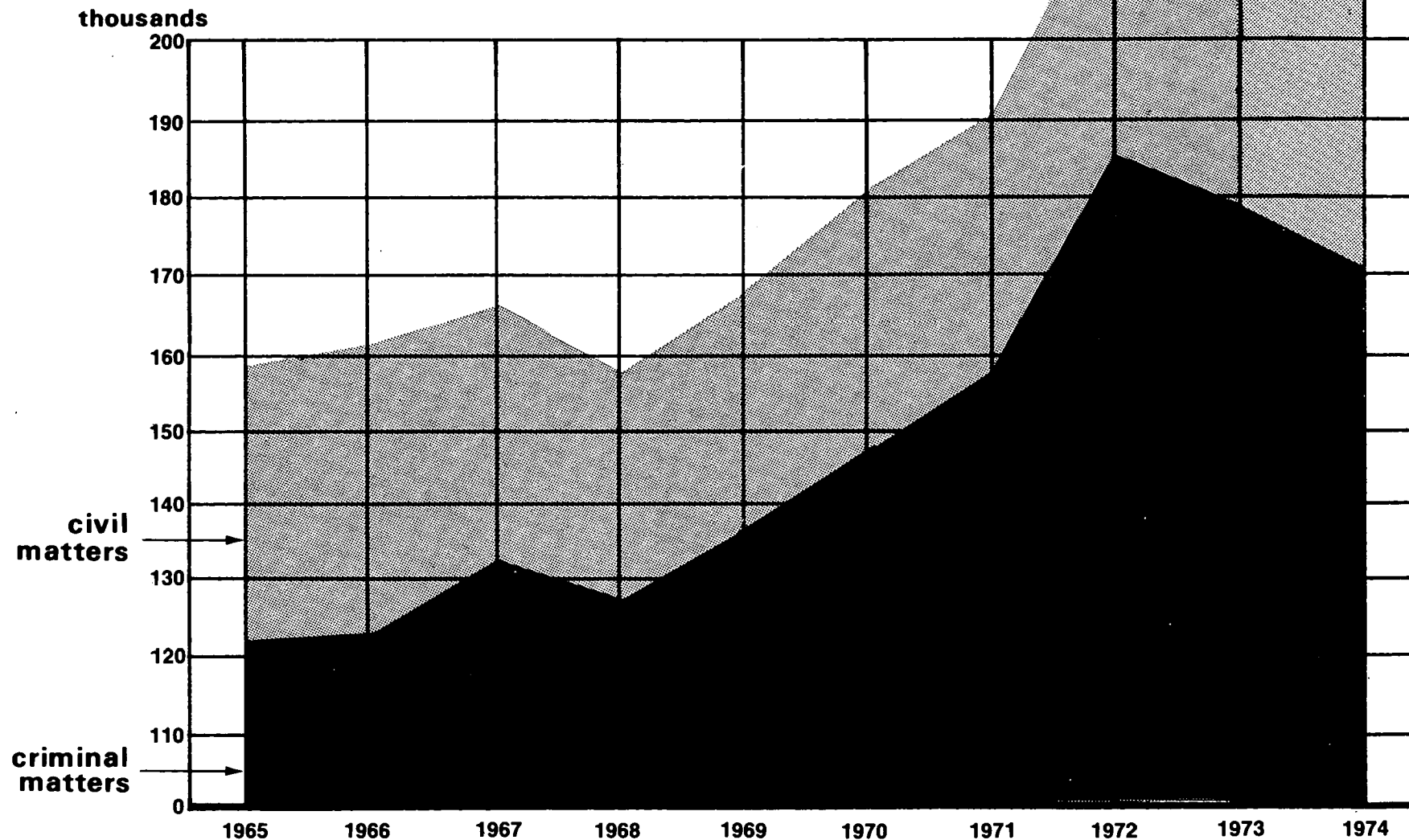

Trials in Criminal and Civil Cases in United States Attorneys' Offices

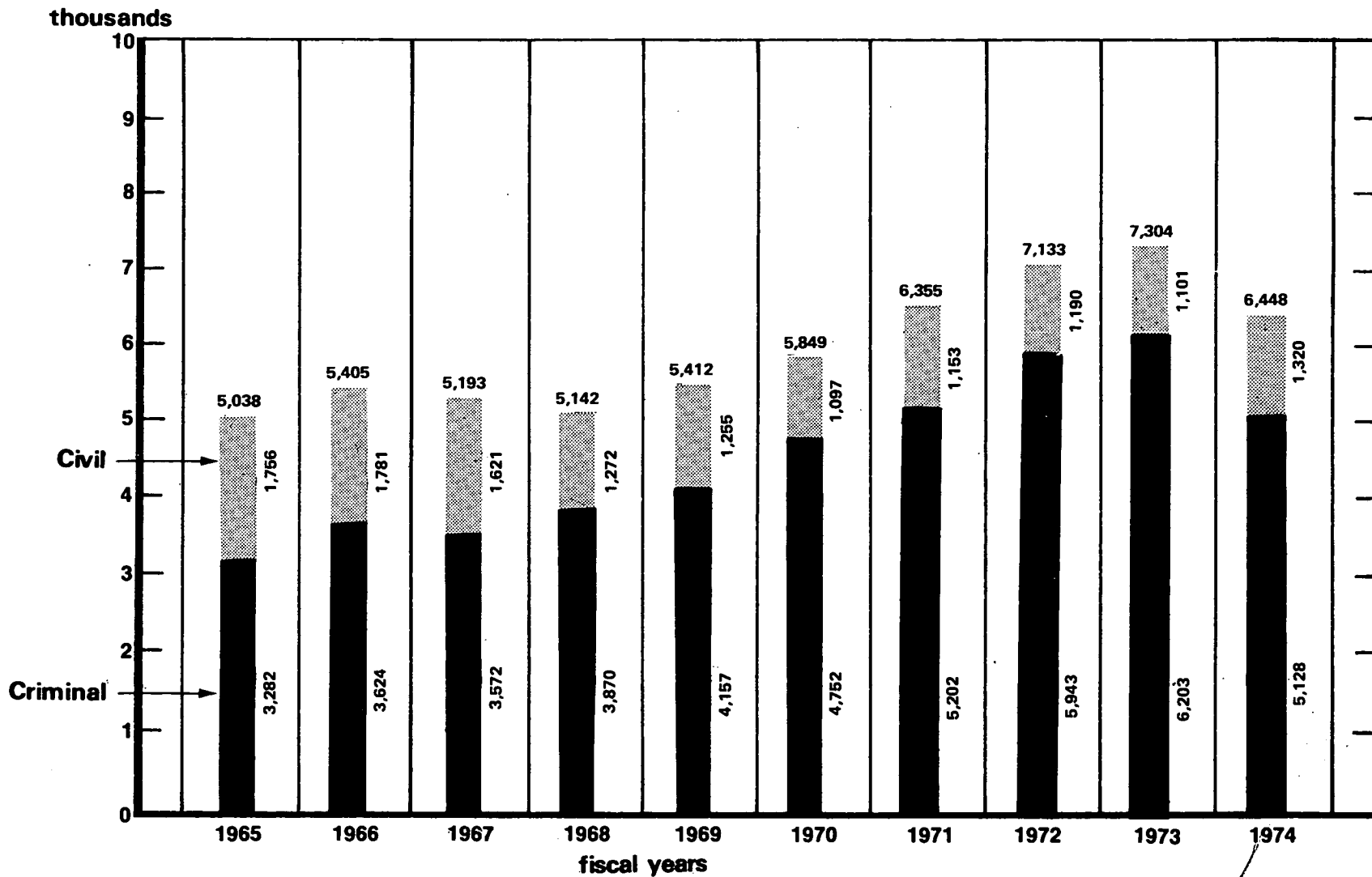

Total 27,644 Cases**

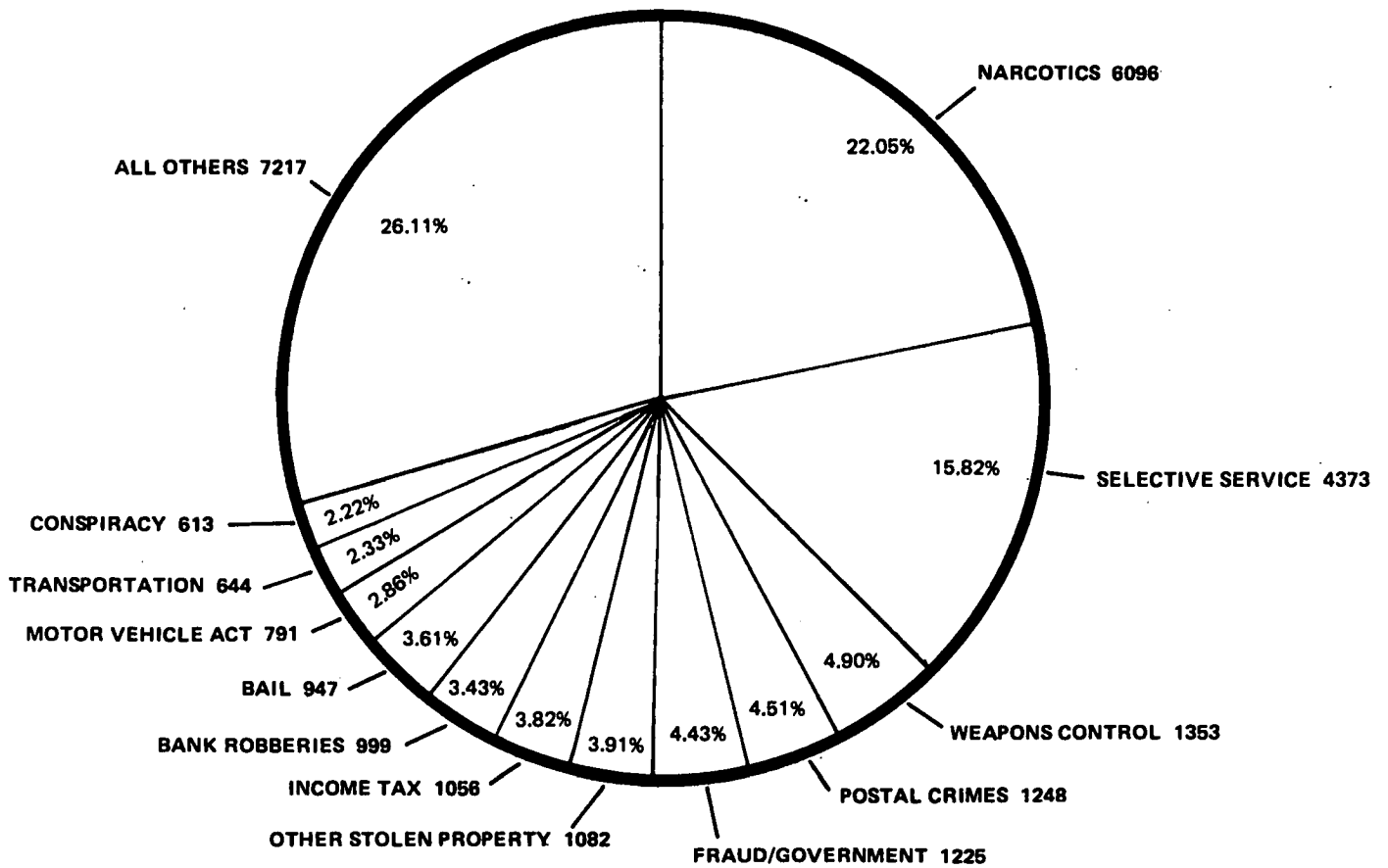

Total 27,644 Cases

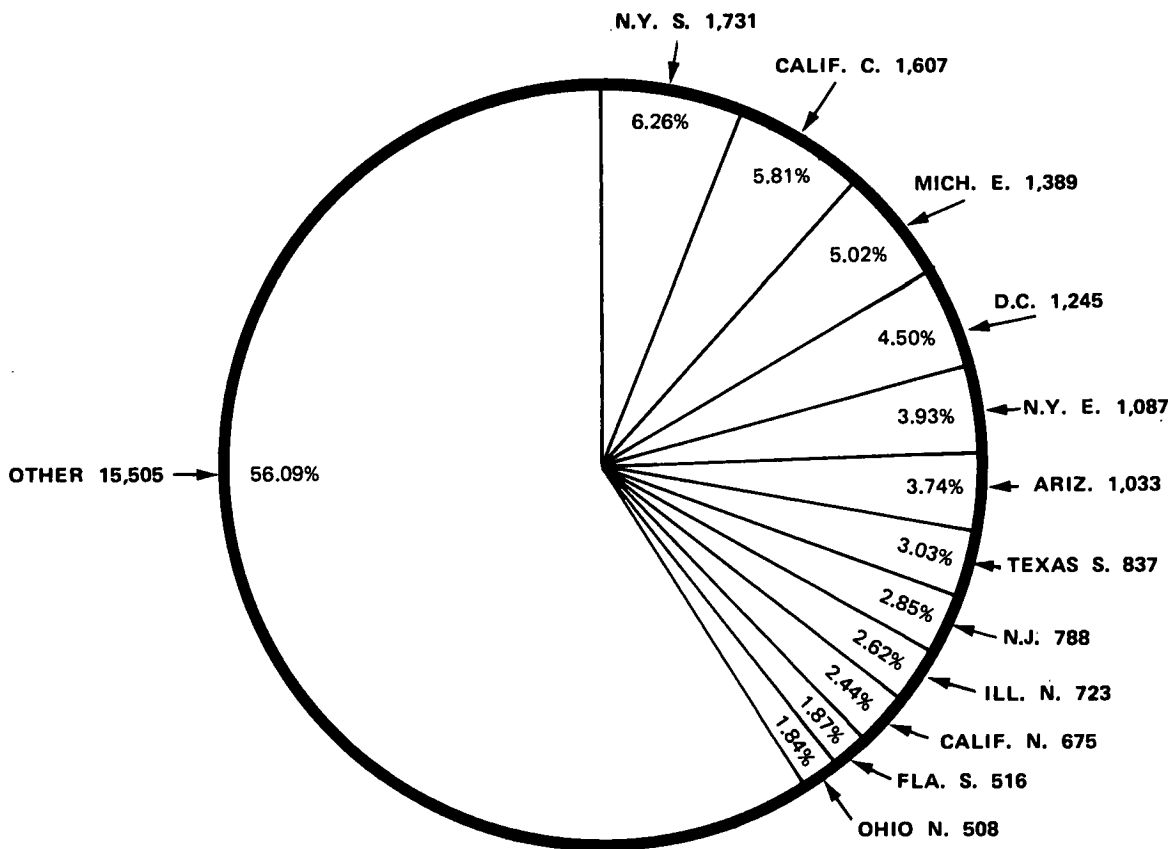

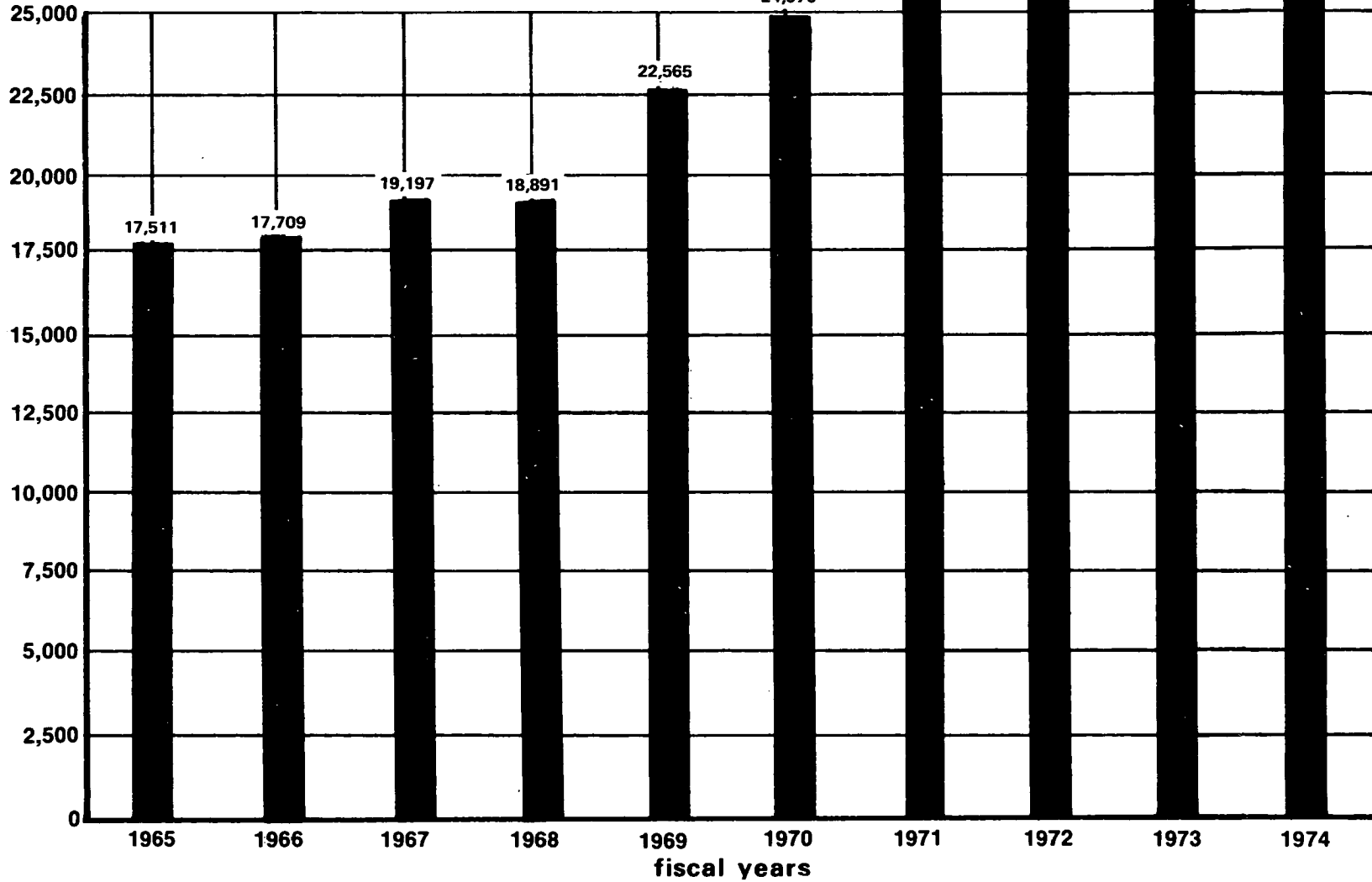

Total Cases Criminal 27,644 Civil 34,173

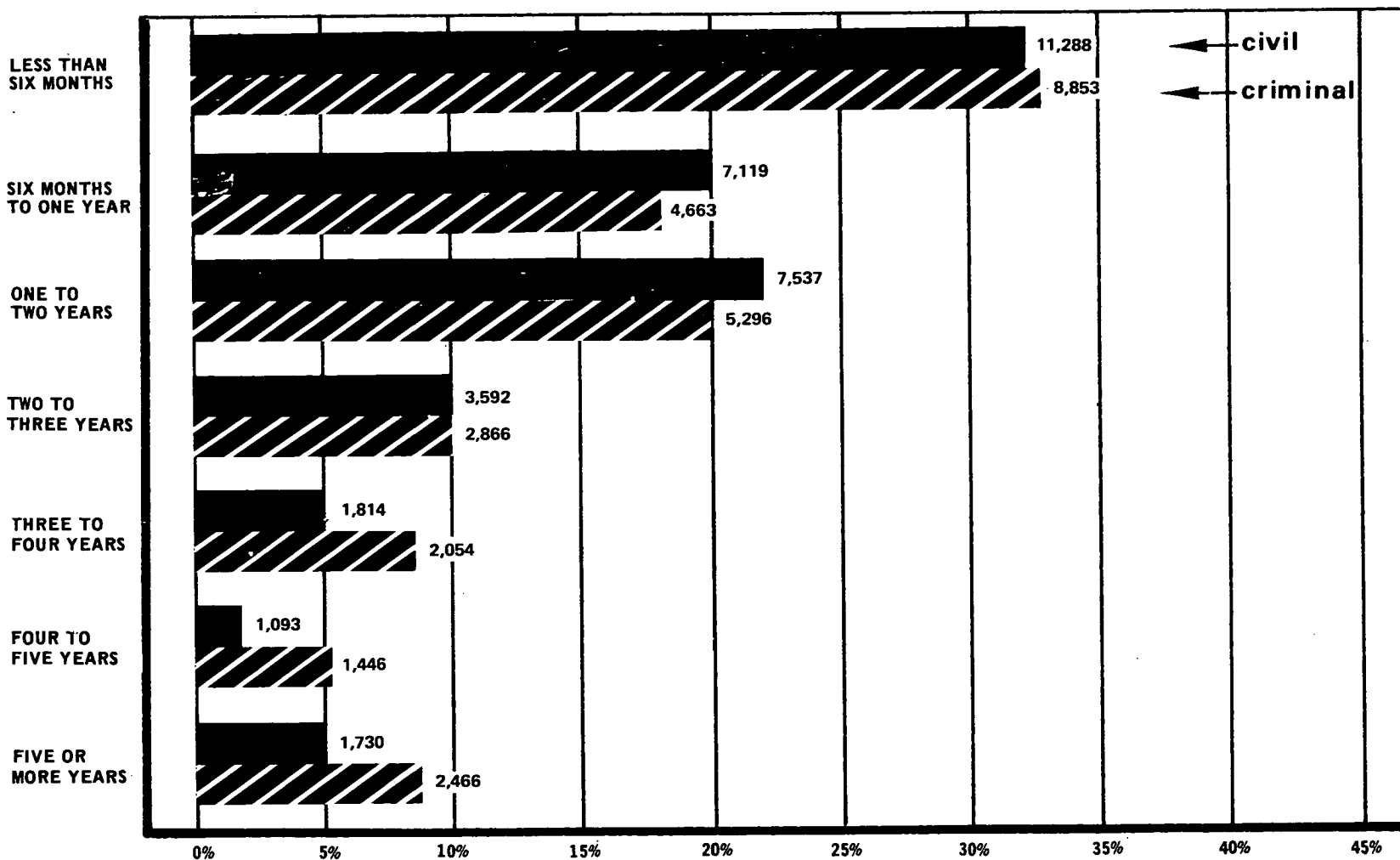

Total 36,088 Cases**

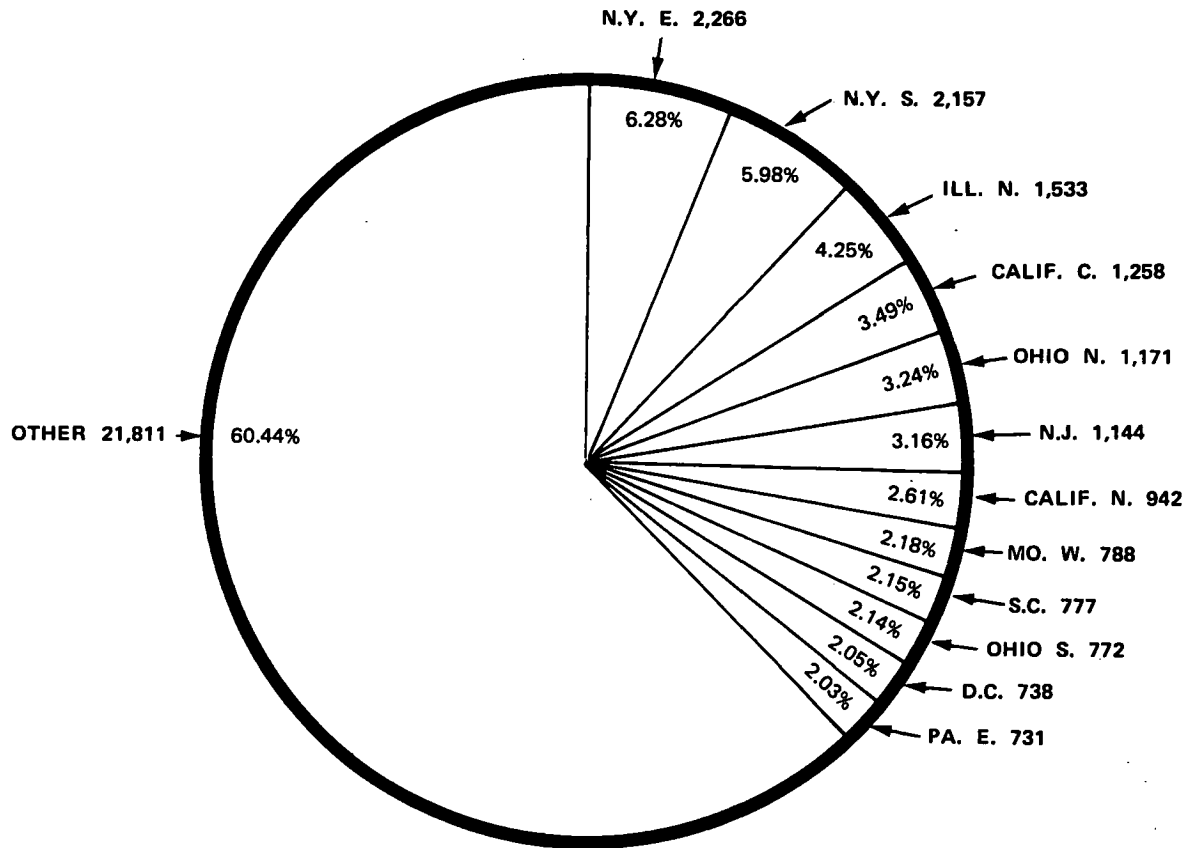

Total 36,088 Cases**

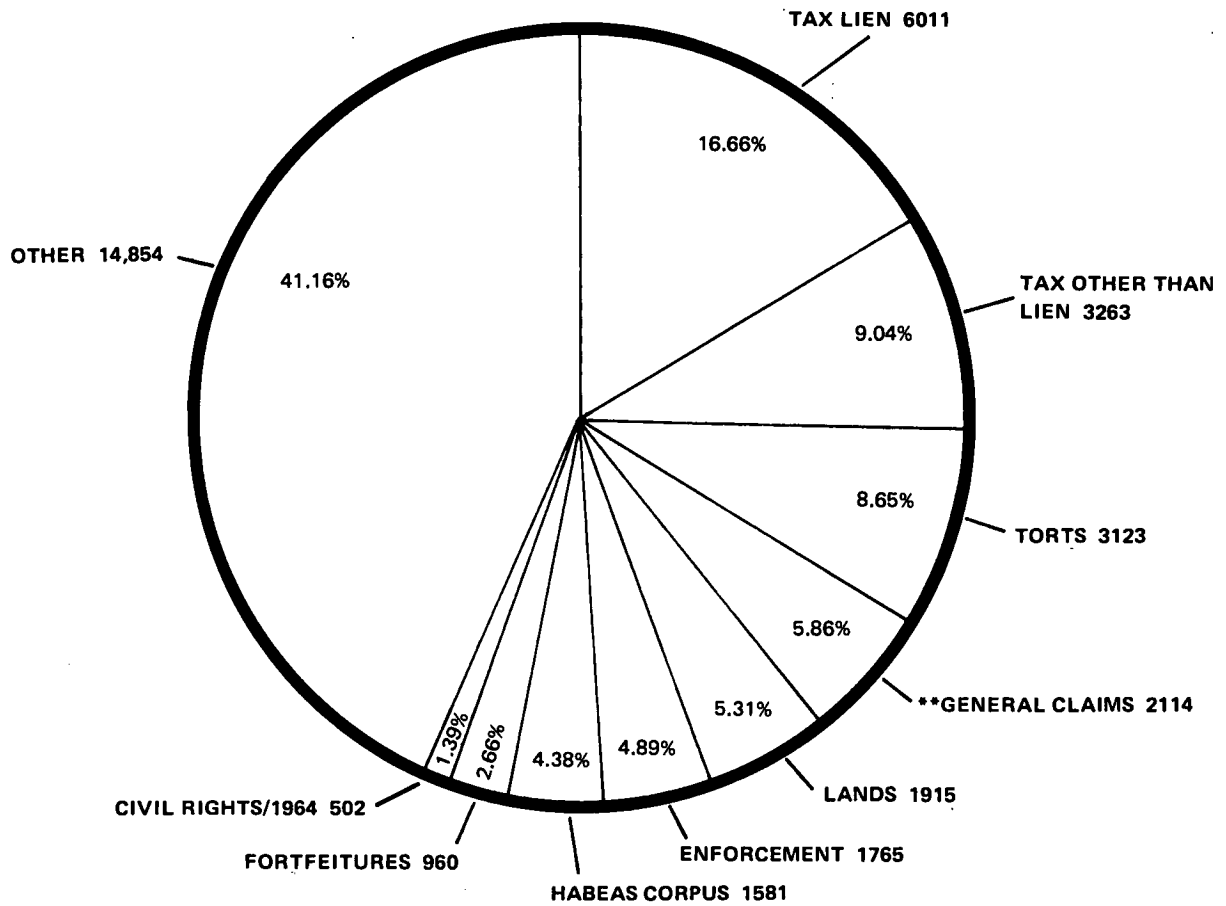

millions of dollars

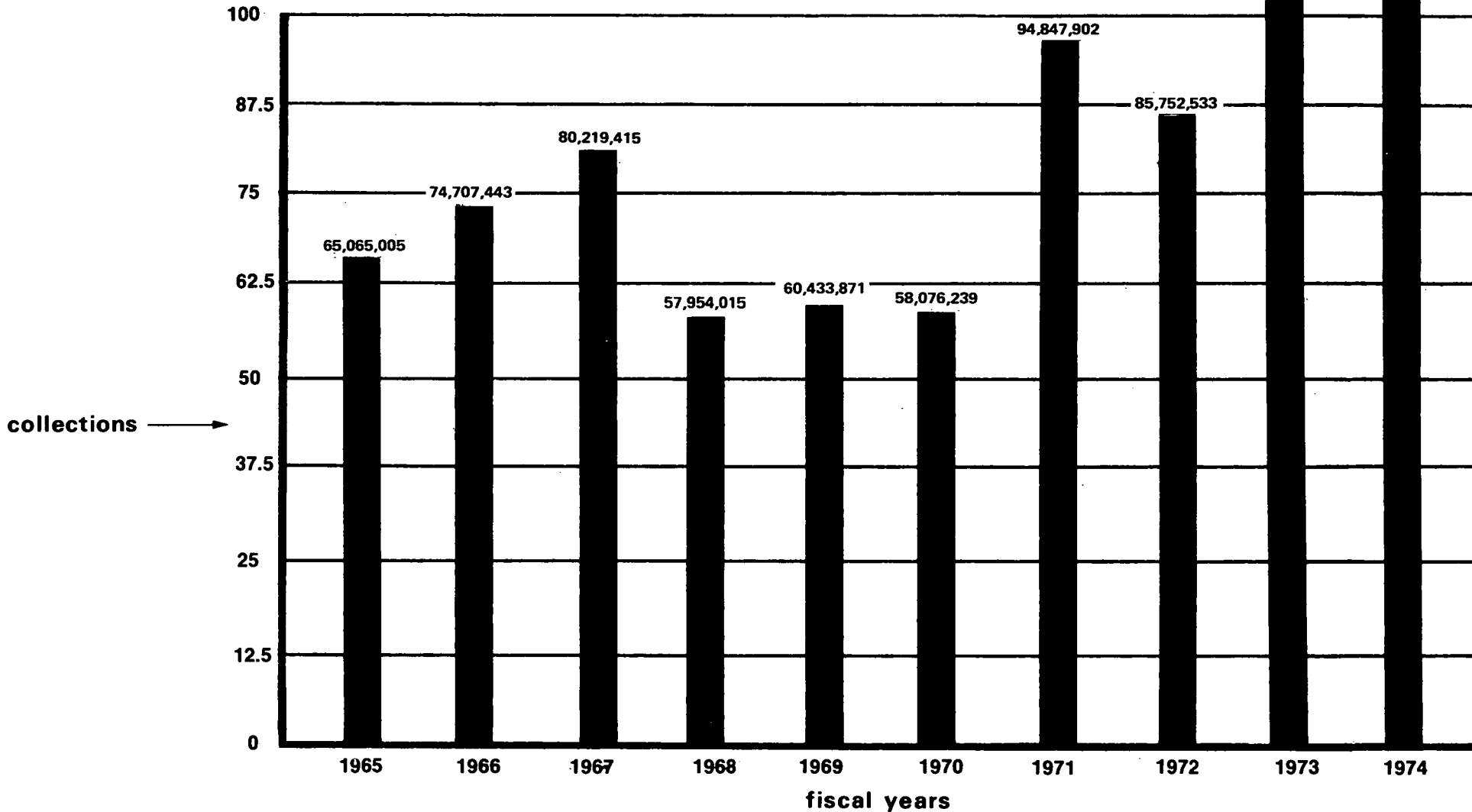


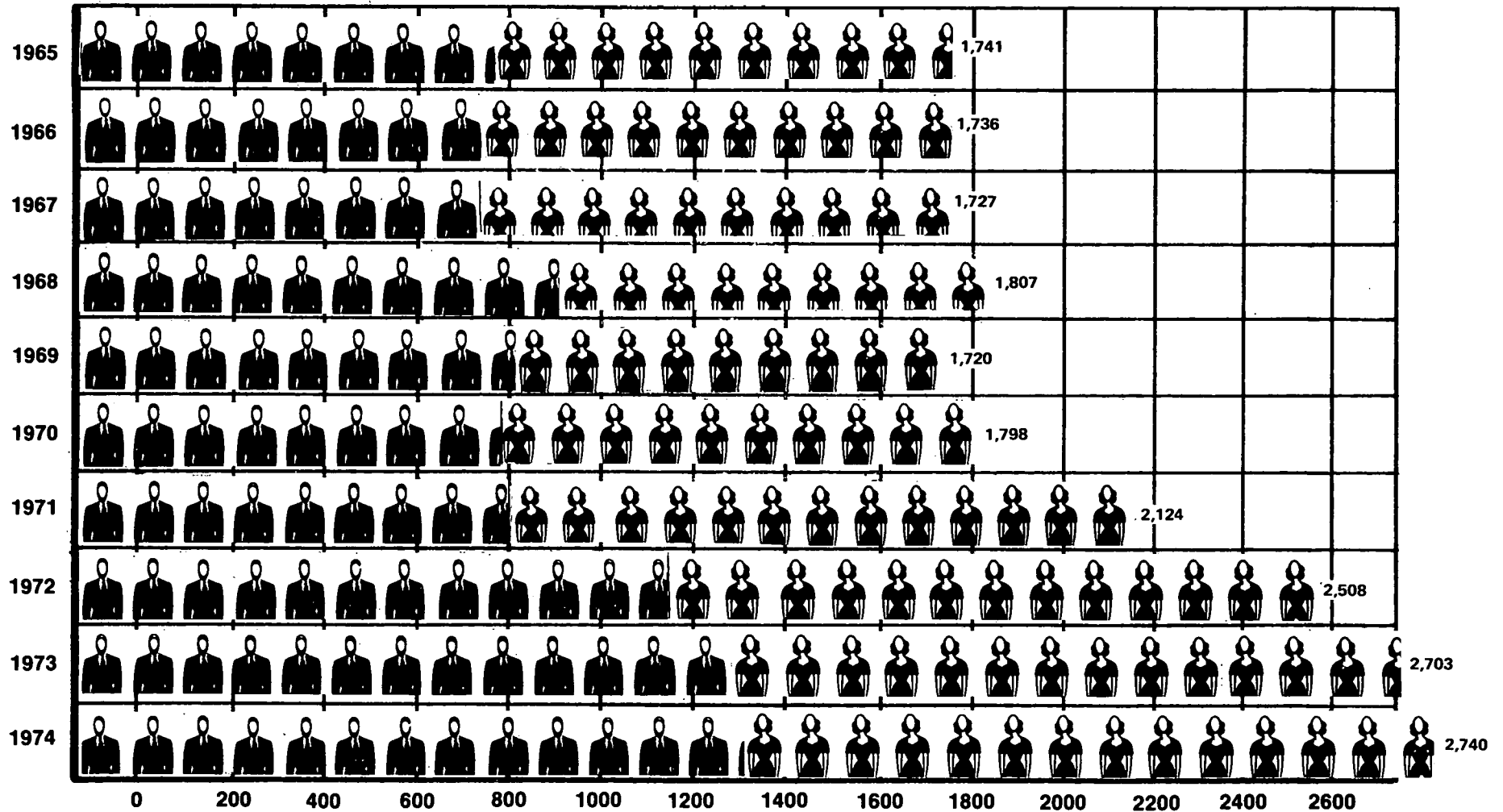
