

COMPARISON OF PAY AND BENEFITS ELIGIBILITY FOR ACTIVE-DUTY PERSONNEL AND NATIONAL GUARD AND RESERVE PERSONNEL ON ACTIVE DUTY

A Report Prepared by the Federal Research Division, Library of Congress under an Interagency Agreement with the Commission on the National Guard and Reserves

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PREFACE

This summary of military pay and benefits, compiled in February 2007, updates and supplements earlier charts, capturing legislative and regulatory changes that have occurred in the past two years. The summary includes legislation through the Department of Defense Authorization Act for FY 2007, Pub.L.No. 109–364, October 17, 2006. The focus of this table is the comparison among the pay and benefits of three statuses of military active duty: active National Guard duty, active duty in a reserve unit, and active duty in a unit of the regular military. U.S. Code Title 37, which authorizes most types of pay and benefits, assigns them directly or indirectly to "active duty" personnel; therefore, in most cases such pay and benefits are identical for the three statuses of active duty, and the recent tendency has been to eliminate rather than expand differences. However, the few remaining differences are worthy of attention. Descriptions of pay and benefits have been summarized for easy reference, with additional explanations provided in footnotes where necessary. U.S. Code sources are provided in the first column, with the pay/benefit title.
