- Probable changes in agency and White House personnel




Obama's R&D Priorities

- Jobs / Innovation + Science
 - Key R&D Agencies: \$13.1 billion (+4.4% from FY2012)
 - \$2.2 billion for advanced manufacturing
 - Permanent R&D Tax Credit (~\$8 billion per year)
 - 100,000 STEM Educators
- A Low-Carbon Economy
- Climate / Natural Resources
- Infrastructure
 - Wireless Innovation Fund / NextGen Air Transport System
- But how much will he be able to accomplish??

in billions of constant FY 2012 dollars



Defense	\$6.7 billion	-9.1 %	2003
NIH	\$2.3 billion	-7.6%	2002
Energy	\$917 million	-8.2%	2008
NSF	\$421 million	-7.6%	2010
NASA	\$705 million	-7.6%	1988
Agriculture	\$175 million	-7.6%	1998
