Savannah River Site Tours for 2013 Announced

AIKEN, S.C. – (Dec. 14, 2012) - In 2013, Savannah River Nuclear Solutions, LLC will once again offer a limited number of Savannah River Site (SRS) tours for the general public.

Twenty-two tours of SRS are being offered, providing an opportunity for approximately 1,100 members of the public to visit the site.

Tour check-in begins at 12:30 p.m. at the Center for Hydrogen Research, located off Highway 278, in Aiken County, near SRS. Participants will be given a safety briefing, overview presentation, general driving tour of the site and a demonstration at the Savannah River Ecology Lab. Tours conclude at 4:30 p.m.

These tours will provide an opportunity to better understand the Savannah River Site's history, current activities and future missions.
