- Apr 15: Tax filing deadline

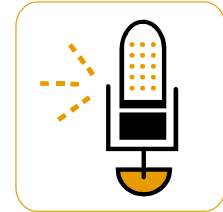

What we do:

The Marne Tax Center is a Third Infantry Division command program supervised by the Office of the Staff Judge Advocate.

We provide a dedicated and trained staff of tax preparers to complete and file your tax return at no charge. Each of our tax preparers is trained and certified directly by the IRS.

At the Marne Tax Center, we prepare both federal and state tax returns. We will also file your return

electronically.

You may choose to pay a commercial tax preparer to complete and file your tax return. However, there are many good reasons to visit the Marne Tax Center instead. First, as mentioned above, we provide our services for free! Second, by electronically filing your return through the Marne Tax Center, you will usually receive your tax refund within 7-10 business days. Third, while many commercial tax preparers

are only open during the tax season, we are open year round. If you file your tax return through the Marne Tax Center and a problem later arises, you can return at any point to the Tax Center to meet with a tax preparer to address the problem.

The Marne Tax Center is an excellent resource for Soldiers, Family Members and Retirees. We look forward to serving you!

What to bring:

ESSENTIAL ITEMS:

- Military ID Card for you and all family members
- Social Security Card for you and all family members
- All W-2s, Form 1099s, and all other statements of income
- Power of attorney (if necessary; give us a call if you are not sure)

OTHER IMPORTANT ITEMS:

- Prior year tax return
- Home mortgage interest statement
- Interest income statements
- ALL OTHER RELEVANT TAX DOCUMENTS!
