## **Post Description:**

The incumbent is responsible for the provision of air traffic control (ATC) services and management of the Kabul International Airport (KAIA) ATC tower and accompanying airspace in accordance with published regulations, whether they be issued by Afghan Civil Aviation Authorities, ICAO, ISAF or NATO. The incumbent exercises supervision of assigned and scheduled personnel on shift duty after being deemed qualified by the KAIA Local Competency Assessor (LCA) as per qualification program. The incumbent must be qualified as an ATC Trainer / Instructor / OJTI (On-Job Training instructor) through an ICAO compliant organisation and continue to possess the skills to provide ATC instruction to previously unrated Afghan personnel in support of the transition of ATC services to Government of Afghanistan.

## **Principle Duties:**

Prepares, provides and assess personnel in OJT as prescribed on the ATC OJT program. Ensures observance of published regulations including ATC procedures, SOPs and LOPs Works multinational civil and military air traffic combined with operations of fixed wing and rotary wing aircraft.

Executes, coordinates, and prepares the provision of ATC services during assigned shift. Supervises, directs, organizes and manages ATC operations and personnel during shift. Maintains contact with command and control agencies and Afghan / international authorities in connection with the provision of ATC services.

Develops flight schedules in coordination with command and control agencies and Afghan / international agencies.

Monitors appropriate safety regulations.

Monitors aircraft flight movements on the ground and in the control zone.

Monitors weather conditions, disseminates and updates facility personnel and agencies.

Disseminates flight plans and required notifications.

Checks incoming messages and posts, files or transfers information to appropriate authority Maintains ATC proficiency and reports.

Liaises with other organizations to ensure safe operation.

Possess valid civil drivers licence.

Administration skills associated to documentation records/instruction.

Must be able to interface/communicate in a multinational environment (language; professional; education; religion, etc.)

The incumbent of the post assists DSATCO for ATC OJT at Kabul International Airport.

USAF (CFACC) is designated the airspace control authority; KAIA AIROPS retains authority (PPR system) for military flights to assigned apron(s); KAIA civil retains authority (PPR system) for civilian flights. KAIA ATC tower operations fall under the authority of ISAF and Commander KAIA as the Senior Airfield Authority. Review aeronautical information publication for detailed information, available at www.motca.gov.af.

A minimum 14 days overlap for rating at Kabul International Airport TWR is required before assuming position responsibilities.

Only applications from candidates meeting essential requirements will be taken into consideration. The successful applicant is required to be proactive in fulfilling the pre-employment conditions. This includes medical examinations and security clearance certificate. Applicant must be able to obtain or to be issued a NATO-recognized national Secret Security Clearance certificate. An initial 12 month contract will be offered and contract extensions may be possible. Because of the dynamic environment, ISAF posts are under regular review and therefore post details and responsibilities, including contract duration and contractual grade may change during the contractual period.
