If qualified, translates from other language(s) to Dari and/or Pashto or to English.

Keeps abreast of issues related to NATO and ISAF policies.

Maintains knowledge of specific and technical fields and the related terminology.

Assists in the compilation of relevant glossaries.

Perform other duties as required.

Accompanies members of IJC & KAIA to official functions and acts as an enabler to allow members of IJC & KAIA to meet local dignitaries. Participates in training organised through the HQ ISAF Chief Linguistic Service.

Ability to interpret and translate at the required level of quality. Sound and up-to-date knowledge of political, cultural, scientific and technical matters, especially related to Afghanistan.

As an interpreter, at all levels, including the highest as well as at public events. For other functions with linguistic colleagues and other ISAF elements.

Contribution to Objectives:

The post holder must be fully aware of the ISAF mission in Afghanistan and be able to contribute whenever possible to helping ISAF to achieve its mission of peace and security for the people of Afghanistan through the work of the Linguistic Service.

Work Environment:

Working conditions range from an office environment to sometimes austere conditions when travelling with military to assist with interpretation.

The Chief Linguistic Service determines the work location as required to meet the operational requirements and in support of the operation.
