Post Description:

The Combined Joint Psychological Operation Task Force (CJPOTF) is the sole asset of International Joint Command (IJC) to communicate directly to the local population through organic mass media. It forms the centre of gravity of the ISAF information effort towards the population within the ISAF Area of Operations (AOO's). The CJPOTF's task is to influence and to inform specific target audiences approved by the North Atlantic Council and explains ISAF's mission and activities to a broad public. Furthermore it creates a supportive atmosphere for the conduct of military operations under the ISAF mandate. The TV Journalist Dari/Pashtu appears on TV for ISAF Productions spoken in Dari and Pashto. Has to work in the studio and office as a translator and in the field as a reporter/interviewer.

Principle Duties:

Trade, research and analyse information on assigned topics/issues.
Gather information from diverse sources.
Produce scripts in both English and Dari/Pashtu.
Identify and purpose informal opportunities, activities and approaches.
Speaks on-air both in the studio and in the field.
Translates into and from Dari and Pashto as required.
Assists Chief TV with pre-testing of products.

Additional Duties:

The incumbent may be required to perform such other related duties as may be directed.
If needed the personnel will be deployed within all ISAF AOO
