



## **Medication Mail Changes**



Effective <u>1 January 2013</u>, the U.S. Postal system must stop the delivery of imported medications (prescription, OTC, vitamins, herbal and dietary supplements) sent to APO/FPO addresses in Germany (per existing law)

\*Affects packages from complies such as TRICARE, VA, Blue Cross/Blue Shield, GNC, Amazon, etc.

#### **How Can You Get Your Prescription Medication??**

<u>If your provider was CONUS-based:</u> Bring your pill bottle (with complete label) to the Pharmacy and we can fill it for 30 days (exception: certain pain meds, psych meds and controlled substances)

<u>If you see a German Provider</u>: Your provider must be in the Preferred Provider Network (i.e. referred by TRICARE) and must write the prescription IAW US Standards (see TRICARE for more details)

#### **Important Notes**

- If you wish to fill a prescription at the WAHC pharmacy, ensure you register at PAD first so our Pharmacists can "see" you in the system (includes AD, ADFM, Retirees, DACs, AAFES, etc.)
- The Pharmacy cannot renew expired prescription but can only issue an emergency refill (30 day supply of maintenance medications) to allow patients time to attain a PCM (exception: certain paid meds, psych meds and controlled substances) AD/ADFM must present an appointment slip first!
- Family members cannot pick up medications for dependents 16 years and older without written permission and ID card

#### **EFMP**

The Exception Family Member Program is to insure that your family member's medical needs can be supported in overseas locations (to include Hawaii and Alaska).

Your Wiesbaden EFMP Case Coordinator, Mrs. Ragan, is located at the clinic to assist you and answer any questions you may have. She has an unscheduled walk-in policy when available.

#### **Key things to remember:**

EFMP can only coordinate screenings and updates if the family member has had a physical within the last year.

Once you are notified you are relocating OCONUS (even within Germany), please allow up to 30 days for the screening and required paperwork to be completed.

Mrs. Ragan can assist with command sponsoring when Soldier is overseas and family member is still stateside.


