Location: The project is located approximately 9 miles east of Monroe, Utah.

Legal Description: The project area is in Township 25 South, Range 1 West Sections 18 & 19, and Range 2 West Sections 13 & 24.

Lat/Long: 38 x 37' x 15.6 N; 111 x 58' x 15.5 W

Project Description:

The Cove Timber Piles Burn Plan covers the piles of machine and hand piled slash that has resulted from the North Clover timber sale. This project is located in Sevier County. Previous treatment on this project includes approximately 173 acres of timber harvest. The project consists of the burning of scattered machine and hand piles throughout approximately 173 acres of timber harvest areas located entirely on National Forest System lands. The primary fuels treatment objective of this pile burn is to reduce the existing wildland fire hazard resulting from activity fuels, thus reducing potential negative effects from future wildland fire to both Forest Service and nearby private lands.
