<u>Purpose</u>: This course will help prepare Soldiers for training analysis, management, and implementation in a geographically dispersed command.

Scope: This course will equip the student with the skills and knowledge required to manage and operate a training section within a recruiting BN/BDE in a synchronous effort to assist the BN CDR/CSM in achieving their mission requirements. All training will prepare Master Trainers for training on the eight Recruiting Functions, knowledge, and skills.

Prerequisites: A Soldier needs to have completed a two-year tour as a Station Commander for a Master Trainer Position, and a two-year tour as a First Sergeant for a Senior Master Trainer position. Experience in the Guidance shop and being a graduate of the V7 Course will be a requirement in FY 11 and out years.

The Master Trainer Course consists of two phases. Phase I must be completed by the candidate NLT 10 days prior to Phase II. Phase II is conducted at the RRS as a resident course consisting of 3 weeks of training. Successful graduation will result in the award of a certificate of completion and will be retro-active to awarding of a DA assigned ASI.
