General Information

Counseling (Personal, Pre-Marriage, Marriage) If something is troubling you, please come in and talk about it. Helping people is our highest priority. Counseling with a chaplain is "confidential." and held under the guidelines of privileged communication. An appointment is recommended, but "walk-ins" are always welcomed. Counseling may be arranged by calling the Chapel at (719) 556-4442 for an appointment. Emergency cases may be seen any time on a walk-in basis during duty hours or by calling the Command Post (719) 556-4555 after duty hours and asking for the Duty Chaplain.

Weddings

Scheduling a Wedding in the Chapel is authorized for all holding a valid Military ID card and are made **by appointment only.** You must initially meet with the chaplain that coordinates weddings who will ascertain your eligibility and explain and help guide you through the process.

Baptisms/Dedications

Water Baptism is a faith specific rite, ordinance, or sacrament. Contact the chapel and we will connect you with the chaplain who best represents your faith group. We have chaplains who provide Infant, Child and Adult Baptism and Infant and Child Dedication.
