Command Sergeant Major Matthew T. Brady assumed responsibilities as the Madigan Healthcare System Command Sergeant Major on July 13, 2012. Previously, he served as the Command Sergeant Major at William Beaumont Army Medical Center, Fort Bliss, Texas.

A native of Rapid City, S.D, he enlisted in the South Dakota National Guard in 1982 and attended basic training at Fort Dix, N. J., and engineer training at Fort Leonard Wood, Mo. He later attended combat medic training at Fort Sam Houston, Texas. He graduated from the University of South Dakota with a Bachelor of Science degree in Health Services Administration and then went on active duty in 1987.

Command Sergeant Major Brady has served at all levels from a company medic for an armor battalion and his assignments as Western Regional Medical Command Operations Sergeant Major and Weed Army Community Hospital Command Sergeant Major.
