

PELVIC PROTECTION SYSTEM



Protective Under Garment (PUG)

The PUG is part of the Pelvic Protection System worn under the Army Combat Uniform trousers next to the skin. The PUG will assist in preventing infections caused by dirt and fine debris of the wounded area stemming from ground-based IEDs.

Protective Outer Garment (POG)

The POG is part of the Pelvic Protection System worn over the Army Combat Uniform trousers. The POG provides the same level of fragmentation protection as the soft armor of the IOTV. The POG will also assist in preventing infections caused by dirt and fine debris of the wounded area. The POG protects the pelvis, groin, femoral arteries and lower abdominal organs caused by ground-based IED threats.



SOLDIERS SHOULD WEAR BOTH PUG AND POG TOGETHER TO PROVIDE MAXIMUM PROTECTION AND PREVENT POSSIBLE CHAFFING
