SUBJECT: Army Federal Agency Workplace Drug Testing Program Random Drug
Testing Rates for Testing Designated Positions (TDP) and Department of
Transportation (DOT)

1. Reference, DoD Directive 1010.9, DoD Civilian Employee Drug-Free Workplace Program, 22 June 2012.
2. Effective 1 October 2012, the maximum rate of random testing for civilian TDPs for will be 100% of the TDP pool over a two-year period or 50% per year. This rate of testing is commensurate with the level of funding received from the Department of Defense for civilian testing. The DOT random testing rate will remain unchanged.
3. AR 600-85, DA Pam 600-85 and the Installation Status Report (ISR) Performance Measure will be update to reflect the random testing rate change.
