Clinical Pharmacy Services at CAVHCS

CAVHCS was established January 1, 1997, from the merger of the Montgomery and Tuskegee VA Medical Centers, which are approximately 40 miles apart. Along with three community based outpatient clinics, these five sites serve more than 134,000 veterans living in a 43-county area of Georgia and Alabama.



CAVHCS exists to provide excellent services to veterans across the continuum of healthcare. A wide range of inpatient and ambulatory care services are provided in the medical center including internal medicine, primary care, surgery, neurology, infectious diseases, nephrology, pulmonary, cardiology, and mental health.
