

Requirements

The applicant must possess a Doctor of Pharmacy Degree from an accredited school of pharmacy and be licensed by a U.S. State Board of Pharmacy.

The applicant must be registered with the American Society Of Health-System Pharmacy Matching Program.

Successful completion of a PGY-1 Pharmacy Residency is required.

All applicants must use PhORCAS to complete an online application.

Application materials must be submitted by January 7th, 2013.

Applicants must also submit Application No. 3 and college transcripts.

All applications must include a letter of intent, 3 professional references and an updated Curriculum Vitae.

U.S. citizenship is required of all applicants.

A minimum GPA 3.0 is required.
