North Florida/South Georgia VHS Pharmacy Residency Program

The pharmacy residency program consists of ASHP-accredited postgraduate year one (PGY1) programs (geriatrics track, ambulatory care track, pharmacy practice and hospital practice track) and postgraduate year two (PGY2) programs (critical care, palliative care/pain management, ambulatory care, psychiatry and pharmacy administration). The PGY2 program in ambulatory care is in ASHP pre-candidate status.

The primary practice site during the residency for most of the programs is the Gainesville VAMC. Exceptions are the three pharmacy practice track residents at the Lake City VAMC, one ambulatory care track residency position located at the Jacksonville Outpatient Clinic and one at the Tallahassee Outpatient Clinic. Most residents will have learning experiences scheduled at facilities other than their primary site during the course of the year.

There is ample opportunity to be involved in patient care, education, management and research. Residents are required to complete a research, clinical or administrative project and are encouraged to present at a professional meeting and required to submit a manuscript suitable for publication by the end of the residency.

The annual stipend is \$41,098 (\$44,522 for PGY2). Staffing is not required during the residency, but may be available to interested residents at pharmacist pay rates.
