The VA Ann Arbor Healthcare System (VAAHS) provides integrated, high quality, cost-effective primary and tertiary healthcare to veterans residing in lower Michigan and northwestern Ohio. VAAHS currently provides patient care in four Michigan locations: Ann Arbor, Flint, and Jackson, as well as Toledo, Ohio.
