#### Purpose Statement for the Salem VA Medical Center PGY-1 Residency Program:

A PGY1 residency program provides the opportunity to accelerate growth beyond entry-level professional competence in patient-centered care, pharmacy operational services, and to further the development of leadership skills.

The residency year provides a fertile environment for accelerating growth beyond entry-level professional competence through supervised practice under the guidance of model practitioners. Specifically, residents will be held responsible and accountable for acquiring these outcome competencies: managing and improving the medication-use process; providing evidence-based, patient-centered medication therapy management with interdisciplinary teams; exercising leadership and practice management; demonstrating project management skills; providing medication and practice-related education/training; and utilizing medical informatics.

Graduates from the PGY1 Pharmacy Residency Program at the Salem VA Medical Center will be prepared to either obtain a position as a clinical or clinical/staff pharmacist or to continue their training via a PGY2 Pharmacy Residency in their desired area of interest or specialty.




