

Perkins County Rural Water

Project Description

The Perkins County Rural Water Project will expand the Perkins County Rural Water System to serve 2,300 people in South Dakota when complete. Funding would complete the Phase VI, Phase VII, and Phase VIII pipeline distribution/storage contracts. The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 funding will finish construction of the Perkins County Rural Water System that can be accomplished within the project's remaining appropriation ceiling.



Project Benefits

Completing these activities will:

- Accelerate completion of the project resulting in more people served with a reliable source of quality drinking water at an earlier date.
- Will also reduce administrative costs by completing the project sooner.
- Will provide drinking water to people that currently have poor quality water or have to haul water.

Project Status

Funding of \$4.438 million was provided to Perkins County Rural Water System on July 15, 2009. The Phase VI distribution contract has been completed and the Phase VII distribution contract is under construction. The Phase VIII distribution contract will begin construction in the Spring of 2011 and is scheduled to be completed by September of 2012.
